STUDY PROGRAM 1st course

«THEORETICAL FOUNDATIONS AND TECHNIQUES (BASIC)»

Total: 2 semesters, 81 main classes, 20 exams: 4.5 academic hours each. When teaching online, in a number of packages, about 30 live webinar classes as well as individual work.

Theme 1. INTRODUCTION (6 classes)

Purpose of the Theme: 1. Presenting key provisions of Esotericism in general and of this course, its possibilities and conditions of study. 2. Providing all the necessary information for decision-making on the appropriateness of training in these programs.

Class themes: 1. Fundamentals of Esotericism. 2. Spiritual Laws. 3. Fundamentals of Spiritual Healing. 4. Interaction with the Subtle World. 5. The effectiveness of training. 6. Opportunities and perspectives.

Semester 1. BASICS OF DEVELOPMENT (5 topics, 42 classes, 10 exams)

Semester Goals:

1. *Presenting key theoretical provisions on Esotericism in general and on this System, which is the basis for introducing appropriate development techniques.*
2. *Presenting key development techniques and forming the initial skills of their application, necessary to achieve one of the final goals - the awakening of abilities and obtaining the possibility of direct interaction with the Subtle World (communication, movement, work).*

The purpose of the theme is to briefly present the main provisions: The Hierarchy of Spiritual Laws that regulate the requirements for a person and their Destiny (in all components, from beliefs to lifestyle and goal setting), appropriate rewards (success, the state of happiness, favorable incarnations) and punishments (from minor to incarnation in the world of animals and hells) of the Subtle World and their main mechanisms (other types of laws for organizations, Society as a whole (civilizations are not considered).

The purpose of the theme is to introduce the basic algorithm of Spiritual Healing, i.e. all key operating procedures, from general diagnostics to the necessary recovery procedures. This algorithm is universal, i.e. almost always, in any work, all its elements are involved, but depending on the qualifications of the healer, of course, each of the elements will have many levels of detailing.

With the abilities and the right approach, a person can develop healing skills further on independently.
