### Build a Robust Search Strategy

#### Develop your search based on your PICO question components

Literature support is required for each step of the project, from implementation through measurement. Search for evidence to define best practice. Separately, search for validated tools for measuring the outcome variables. Provide samples of how this intervention has been implemented and studied before (may be empirical research, lab research, or previous EBP reports). Consider professional groups or associations that might have curated information on the topic already.
