*Prom tickets will be on sale until Friday, April 12. The cost per ticket is \$50 and can be purchased in the cafeteria during lunch ONLY. You can pay with cash or check to LHS. Online payment for prom tickets is not available

*Prom tickets may **ONLY** be purchased by a member of the current LHS Junior or Senior class.

*When purchasing a ticket, you will be required to choose the table you would like to sit at during Prom. Students wishing to sit together need to purchase their tickets on the

same day, as switching tables will **NOT** be permitted this year. Each table seats 10 people and the walkthrough time for that table will be listed when purchasing the tickets.

*Each Junior/Senior is permitted to bring **ONE** guest outside of the current LHS Junior or Senior class. If the Junior/Senior chooses to walk through Prom Preview, their outside guest **must** walk with them. The guest **must** be seated at the same table as the Junior/Senior. COLLEGE INFO:

• URGENT read for any senior planning to attend college or trade school next year. The FAFSA must be filed by April 15 to be eligible for any Indiana financial aid. This includes any 21st Century Scholars. Indiana has one of the most generous need-based college financial aid systems in the U.S., ranking 1st in the Midwest and 4th in the nation, with more than \$300 million in state aid awarded to Hoosier students annually. Unfortunately, every year thousands of high school seniors miss out on this critical opportunity by failing to file the FAFSA—Free Application for Federal Student Aid-by Indiana's April 15 deadline.

Without a current FAFSA on file, prospective college students are ineligible to receive federal, state and college financial aid dollars, and they may miss out on local scholarship opportunities as well. We are a less than two weeks away from the deadline for students to file the FAFSA.

FAFSA Support

The Indiana Commission for Higher Education has set a goal to increase the number of Hoosier seniors who complete an on-time FAFSA. The Commission provides real-time FAFSA data to equip education leaders, staff, administrators and community partners with the data needed to ensure their students are on track.
