Scarborough Beach reminds me of the beaches of Southern California back in the sixties with its old-style changing rooms and open-air gazebos with benches for shade. I take a break from the boogie board to lie down on a soft blanket under the big blue sky, friendly sun, and wispy clouds, with the insistent, beckoning sound of waves taking up space in my head instead of the usual clutter.

The sun and the ocean are endlessly healing for living a life with Grief, my ever-changing yet always-just-around-the corner-companion. We take a slow walk on the surf's edge followed by coffee-heathbar-crunch ice-cream cones at Point Judith, where we sit on large, flat rocks and watch the ferry - just like my feelings - glide in and glide out.
