

1st Grade Sight Word Lesson Plan

Grade: Kindergarten

School: Middle Township Elementary #1

Learning Goals:

- I can read this sight word
- I can “arm tap” (spell) this sight word
- I can use this sight word in a sentence

Standards:

- **LA.L.K.2.A** Capitalize the first word in a sentence and the pronoun I.
- **LA.L.K.2.D** Spell simple words phonetically, drawing on knowledge of sound-letter relationships.
- **LA.RF.K.3.C** Read high-frequency and sight words with automaticity.

Activating Strategy:

Orton Gillingham (OG) 3 Part Drill (Visual, Auditory, Blending) of the previous letters that were taught

- Students will be shown the small letter cards (phonics first) and they will say the letter being shown, the picture clue that goes with the letter, and the sound the letter makes
- Students will “tap out” and blend the sounds in 5 CVC words (these words could be real words or “nonsense” words)
- The teacher will then give students a sand tray and say 3 letter sounds (1 letter at a time). The students have to write the corresponding letter in the sand
- The students will review previously learned sight words

Teaching:

- Sight Word of the day- **long**
- Give students 2 sentences that have the day's red word
- Pose the question to the students “what is today's sight word?”
- Multisensory activities
 - Trace in red crayon on bumpy board 3 times
 - Arm tap 3 times
 - Write in the sky 3 times
 - Trace the bumps on the index card 3 times
 - Write in the sand tray 3 times
- Sight Word Worksheet
 - Trace the word “long” 3 times with red crayon
 - Write 3 times on the line in red crayon

Summarizer:

- Cut out the pieces to the sentence at the bottom of the page

- The teacher will say the sentence 3 times for the students to hear, then the students will glue the sentence in order on the paper
- Write the sentence on the line
- Read the sentence after writing

- Review materials: letter cards, previous sight words, blending board
- Red crayons
- Bumpy screens
- Sand trays
- Sight word worksheets
- Pencils
- Erasers
