

Registration platform: Our registration system, Eleyo, is a mobile-friendly online platform that allows families the convenience of setting up an online profile—allowing you to input basic information in advance, connect multiple family members, view program details and schedules for classes your family is enrolled in, access receipts and more!

Double check the dates, times, grades and location of the class before purchase. Classes are often offered at multiple locations and dates, times, and/or grades may vary.

Please note that classes fill quickly.

Registrations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. Register early to avoid being closed out.

Waitlists: If a class is full and you wish to place your child on the waitlist, click "Enroll Now", then you will be prompted to "Enroll on the waiting list". Follow the prompts from there. Be sure to hit the Pay \$0 button to finalize your place on the waitlist. You will be contacted if a space becomes available.

Confirmations: Once you are registered, you will receive a confirmation email from Eleyo, our online registration system. You can check on your active registrations by logging into your Eleyo account at any time.

Enrollment Policy: Students may only register for NCE classes at the school they currently attend, unless specified.

Scholarship assistance is available: No student will be denied access into an NCE program due to an inability to pay. Families experiencing financial hardship may apply for 60% off one NCE class per session, per child. If you have completed the District's Free and Reduced Meal application the student may receive 85% off one NCE class.

Refund Policy: Participants may withdraw from a class and receive a refund, less a \$15.00 processing fee, if you notify NCE three weeks prior to the start of class. NCE is unable to offer refunds or credits for missed classes and is unable to offer refunds or credits for withdrawals made after the three week mark. Refunds come in the form of a check from the Town of Needham and may take up to four weeks to arrive by mail.

Canceled Classes: Sometimes an NCE class has to be canceled, due to low-enrollment or an instructor no longer being able to teach the class. When a class is canceled, all registrants will be contacted immediately and will receive a full refund. Refunds come in the form of a check from the Town of Needham and may take up to four weeks to arrive by mail.

Special Considerations: NCE programs are open to all Needham Public Schools students. NCE provides equal access to its programs for children with and

without disabilities. If there are special considerations we should know about so that your child may access our programs, please share them in the designated area of the registration form. NCE does not have access to a child's IEP or Section 504 Plan, therefore NCE encourages parents to additionally disclose any medical- or disability-related needs in the Special Needs section in their child's online profile -- more information is better than less.

If you believe your child requires a specific reasonable accommodation for medical- or disability-related needs, please contact our office to discuss your child's needs at least two weeks prior to start. If it is determined that your child requires additional support staff to access a program due to a disability, NCE will work to provide such additional staff. If, however, NCE is unable to secure extra support staff, we will notify you and provide a refund for the program. Similarly, if your child is unable to participate in a program on a specific day because a needed support staff person is out sick or otherwise unavailable to attend your child's program, NCE will refund the cost of the program for that specific day.

Notify Your Child's School and

Classroom Teacher: Please notify your child's school <u>AND</u> classroom teacher of the dismissal change. Please include the dates that your child should be dismissed to the NCE program.

For Students in NEDP: Students enrolled in NEDP may also register for NCE Elementary programs. NEDP students will be escorted to NEDP at the end of their NCE class. Note: Please provide NEDP with a Dismissal Change Form to notify NEDP that your child will be attending their NCE class and arriving at NEDP upon its conclusion.

Absences: For the safety of our students, if your child attends school but does not plan to attend their NCE class, please notify your child's school of the dismissal change AND notify the NCE office at NCE@needham.k12.ma.us or 781-455-0400 x5.

Arrival: NCE classes will begin at the end of the school day. Students are dismissed to the designated NCE waiting area at their school, where they will be supervised by the NCE OnSite Coordinator until their Instructor arrives to escort the students to their classroom.

Dismissal: The NCE OnSite Coordinator will dismiss children from the front lobby of each school location. Children will not be permitted to leave on their own unless they have been designated as a walker on their registration form or with anyone other than their parent/guardian unless NCE has been notified. Please pick up your child promptly.

No Transportation: No transportation is provided between schools or home for NCE program participants.

Late Pick-Up Fee: For safety reasons, students must be picked up promptly at dismissal time. If you are delayed, there is a 5-minute grace period before late charges begin. A fee of \$25 will be charged for each late pickup (beyond the 5-minute grace period). NCE will bill you for the charges. Your child may not attend the next class until the late fee is paid.

Early Dismissal from NCE Classes:

Parents/guardians must notify NCE at NCE@needham.k12.ma.us or 781-455-0400 x5, no later than 1:00pm on the day of class if their child needs to be dismissed early from their NCE class. This will allow us to have your child packed up and ready for pick up at the requested time.

Inclement Weather: If the Needham Public Schools are closed or released early due to inclement weather, all NCE after-school and evening classes will be canceled.

Make Up Classes: If a class is canceled due to inclement weather or instructor absence, a make up class will be planned in the weeks to follow, with the scheduled instructor or a sub. If a class cannot be rescheduled, NCE will provide a pro-rated refund for the canceled class. Cancelation refunds will be processed at the end of the class session. Refunds come in the form of a check from the Town of Needham and may take up to four weeks to arrive by mail.

School Vacation / Holidays: Classes will not be held on school holidays or school vacation weeks (unless specifically indicated). Please refer to the specific class for "no class" dates.

School Policies: All school policies outlined in each school's Student Handbook apply to NCE Elementary programs held at those locations.

Snacks: Participants in NCE Elementary after school programs are encouraged to bring a water bottle and **NUT-FREE snack** to enjoy during the gathering time between school dismissal and the start of their NCE class.
