For all of our tech kids in town, we bring a fun coding challenge! This challenge was created by Ana Sepetovska, Software Engineer at Microsoft and Anya Parker-Lentz, CEO at Landau Agency.

Registration: Opens Feb 15, 2022
Closes March 13, 2022 at midnight

Submission Date: Submissions must be received by midnight on March 19, 2022
Winners will be announced by the end of March

Eligibility: This challenge is open to Millburn students in grades K-12.

Teams: Students can work individually or as a team. Teams can consist of 1-4 students. Every Team member needs to register individually. At the time of submission of the project, team details will be recorded.

NOTE: Siblings of different ages are allowed to be together in one team but the team needs to participate in the level corresponding to the oldest sibling/team member.

Levels:

BEGINNER
For Elementary School students
Projects will be in **Scratch**
Recommended experience level: At least 3 months of coding

CODER
For Middle/High School students
Projects will be in **Python**
Recommended experience level: Less than one year of coding

HACKER
For High School students
Projects will be in **Python or Java**
Recommended experience level: More than one year of coding

Prizes: Top three winning entries in each category will get gift cards

- 1st Place - \$150
- 2nd Place - \$100
- 3rd Place - \$75

Top three winning entries in each category (if it's a Team, then each Team member) will get a Certificate of Achievement

Format of entries: Teams will record a video, up to 5 min, for submission. They will upload the video on YouTube. The video needs to be set as 'Unlisted' (Anyone with the video link can watch your video) and not viewable to the public. The team will be asked to submit the YouTube URL link.
