### 1. Claim (1-2 sentences):

- What is the cartoonist trying to say about the Spanish-American War, U.S. involvement, or imperialism?

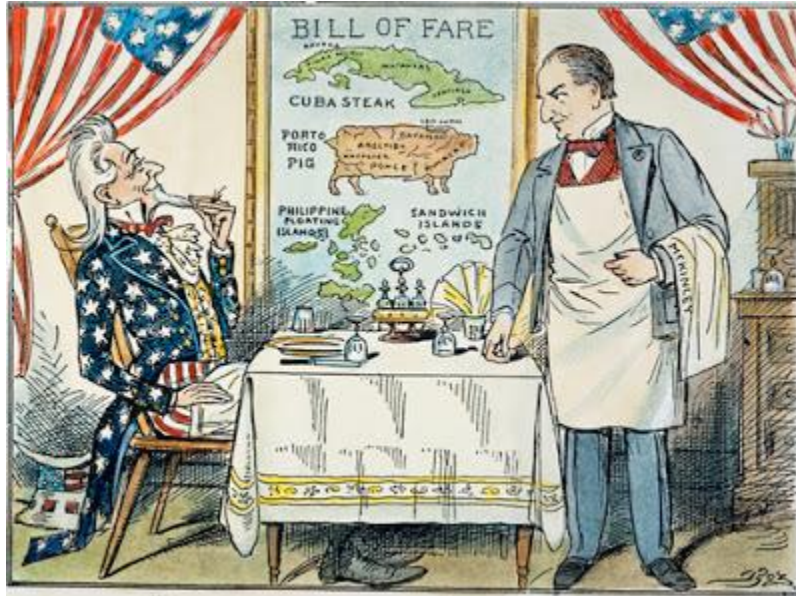
### 2. Evidence (2-3 pieces):

- These could be objects, symbols, characters, labels, or words.

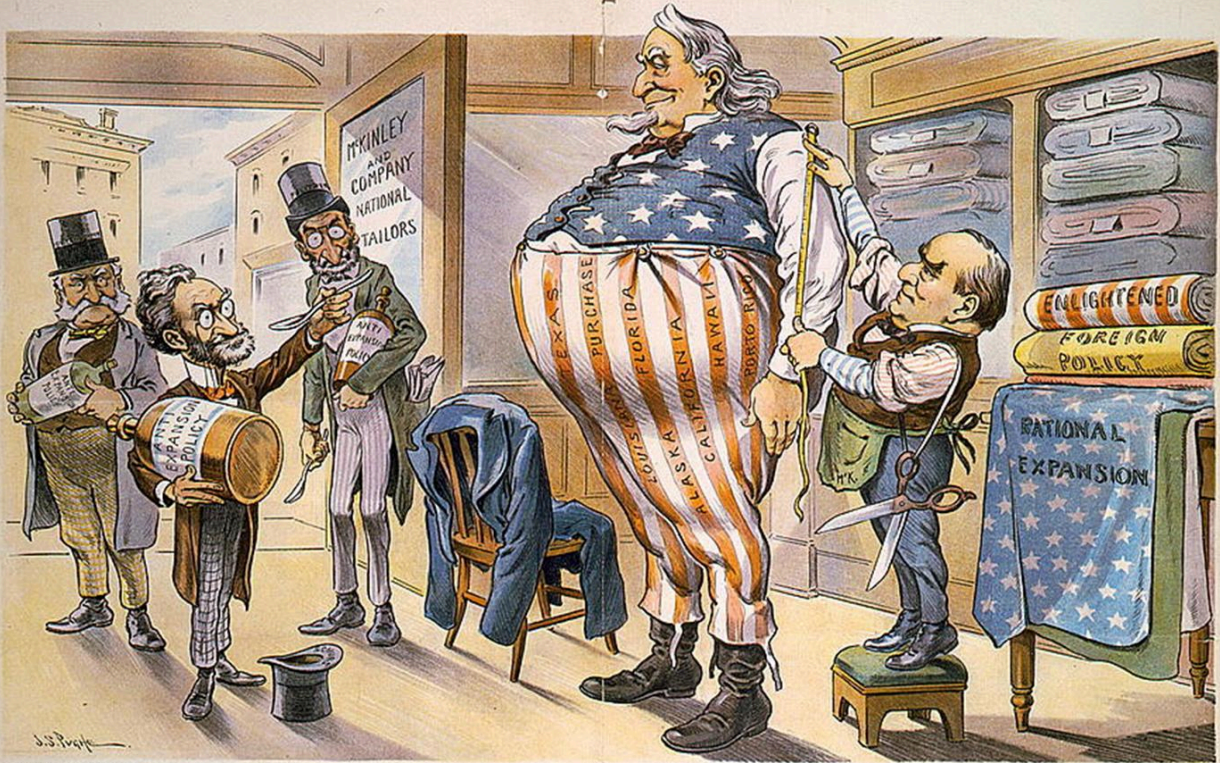
### 3. Reasoning (3-5 sentences):
