9-12, Job opportunity: Blue Lavender Garland is looking for people willing to help with set up and tear down after events. This would mean putting up large event tents and chairs and removing them. The work would be as needed. Typically, set up would be on Wednesday from 8-11 or 12pm, and take down would be 8am-10am on Sunday or Monday. They will hire 14+. They can help with transport to the locations. Roughly, the pay is \$100 per tent set up and less for take down. This will start in June and finish up in August. Again, this could be regular work if they have enough events, so it could be something you do once and a while. [See flyer here.](#)
