SPECIAL NOTES:

- Students must be present at the beginning of the exam period to take the exam and must remain for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
- Any student that does not make up exams by December 20, 2024 will receive a ZERO as an Exam grade.
- Students will be asked to turn off electronic devices and place them in their book bags or on the teacher's desk prior to exams beginning. Students violating this policy will be *dismissed* from testing and a misadministration will be declared for that student. The student will then be required to make up the missed exam on the designated make up day. Per JCPS Board Policy, the student is also subject to disciplinary action by school administration.
- High School students (9-12) will not be required to take a teacher-made final exam in a course in the following situations:
 - The student has an average of 80 or above the week prior to the administration (December 11, 2024) of the exam and has no more than 1 unexcused absences in the class; or
 - The student has an average of 90 or above the week prior to the administration (December 11, 2024) of the exam and has no more than 2 unexcused absences in the class.
 - Notwithstanding grades and absences, any student who has been assigned and received out of school suspension during the term of the class shall not be eligible for exam exemption. Teacher-made tests are defined as tests designed and graded by a JCPS teacher of record for the purpose of assigning an exam grade to a student. Exam exemptions only apply to teacher-made tests and are not available in courses which require the administration of an End of Course or state mandated final exams. Students enrolled in AP courses will still be required to take the AP exam.
- Exam exemptions *will **NOT** apply* to high school courses with required state End of Course (EOC) exams or Career and Technical Education (CTE) state exams."
- County Exams as listed above are NOT eligible for exemption consideration.
- Reminder: There is no bus transportation until 2:15 pm. If students do not have personal transportation for early release, they will report to the proper classroom.
