You can find descriptions of the project Days below:

June 12 Fishing Fun! (Knapp pond, Knapp WI)

Join us at the pond in Knapp, WI to learn about Wisconsin fish, make a travel fishing set, and cast your line! This program is perfect for youth new to fishing, or experienced youth who want to go fishing with friends. Everything you will need (Poles, bait, tackle, etc.) will be available.

June 19 Splash Science

Youth will learn about water and how it moves by playing with water balloons and doing fun experiments outside. Swim suits are not necessary, but please wear something that can get wet.

June 26 Edible Engineering

Learn the science behind engineering by using tasty items! Youth will build using graham crackers, pretzels, frosting and more. They will also use some of the same ingredients to make a tasty snack.

July 10 Recycled Paper and Stamps

Youth will learn how to make paper and stamps. While you make your paper, they can also add color, botanicals and seeds. Imagine planting a corner of your paper to see what grows! Also, during this project day, we will make decorative stamps to take home to decorate their recycled paper. Plant it, decorate it, give it as a gift, or enter it in the fair. It is all up to you!
