

## Anti-Wipe

There seems to be an exploit that allows players to avoid wiping by jumping into the void while combat-tagged. It disables collision on the void brick/trigger, causing them to fall straight through the void without triggering a wipe or landing on the actual void block.

This is not possible through normal gameplay. The void currently has collision and still wipes legitimate players, making this behavior blatant exploit usage.

## How It Seems To Work

- Player jumps into the void while combat-tagged
- Void collision is bypassed or disabled client-side
- Player falls through the void instead of wiping
- Player survives despite being combat-tagged

Changing or bypassing part collision is only possible through exploits.

## Evidence – Observer PoVs

These clips show how the exploit appears from other players' PoVs::

- PoV #2 - **Important:** The player checks that they still have the exploiter combat tagged (**00:43**) almost **20 seconds** after they fell into the void.

In both clips, the player clearly does not wipe after entering the void.

## Exploiter's Own PoV

The exploiter uploaded their own PoV clearly showing them falling through the void brick:

- In the video, the exploiter falls through the voidbrick into the outer void.
- This is then followed by them **immediately** removing their applied combat-tags to make it seem like they have been wiped, shown at 00:18.

This is **extremely** suspicious behavior, and the fact they **rushed** to remove the applied combat-tags makes it seem unnatural and not coincidental.

## Void Still Works Normally

Testing confirms this is not a game bug:

- Falling into the outer void (beyond voidbrick) while combat-tagged **will still wipe you.**

- The void still has collision

Definitely seems to be exploit based.

## Combat Tag Bug

This seems to also indirectly cause the ghost combat tag bug (which is a known bug) as you can see here:

**Notice:** Exploiters often do not understand this side effect and end up creating bug reports asking why they wiped afterward.

## Another Exploiter PoV

Another exploiter's PoV shows the same behavior:

- In the video, the exploiter seems to be acting joyful and careless, giggling even (00:15), followed by no reaction as to falling through the voidbrick.
- They also seem to suspiciously question as if they knew the answer whether they wiped near the end (00:22).

Obviously however, a reaction isn't going to define whether they are an exploiter or not, but it is an important contextual factor.

## Obvious Exploiter Combat Tag Bugged From It

- In the video, the likely exploiter is experiencing the combat tag bug, likely because they used the exploit and then respawned - they made a bug report about it and showed this video.
- The account they're linked to in the Discord is their main, and the account they play on (in the video) was made only three months ago.
- They also only joined the discord about a week ago (12/16/25)

Obviously there are other ways that this could've happened, but considering the fact that they're on an alt whilst playing that only has Deepwoken and was created recently indicates that they're likely exploiting.
