Director's Report

Holdings and Circulation

Our circulation for March 2025 was 689, plus 20 honor books and puzzles for a total of 709. The circulation for March 2024 was 786, so there was a decrease of 77 in circulation. Through Libby, there were 350 checkouts.

Library Wireless

According to the report generated by our router, in March there were 59 unique clients, with an average of 7 clients per day. On March 26th, there was an above average usage for a Wednesday. The bandwidth usage was 680% higher than the last ten Wednesdays recorded.

Inter-Library Loan

In March, we received 52 books and other items to fill requests made by our patrons. And we sent 203 items to other libraries for their patrons.

New Patrons

In March, we registered 13 new patrons.

Collection Development

Last month we added 65 adult books, 5 young adult book, 56 children's books, 17 DVDs, and 17 magazines. In March of 2024, we discarded 18 adult books, 1 young adult book, 9 children's books, and 49 magazines.
