

Transfer Information from Community Colleges to UCs

Notes: Information is gleaned from [here](#), the California Community College's Transfer Data resource guide. This guide can be used to understand the differences between acceptance rates from high school to a 4 year college and from a community college transfer pathway to a 4 year college. All community colleges in California are represented on this resource guide.

There are many factors that should be considered when looking at the application admission data, including a student's major, experience, and background, and the institution's priorities. Contact the admissions departments at any college for further information. This information should be used only as a guide and long-range data covering several years can be found on the California Community College's Transfer Data resource guide. This information is not a substitute for a student's due diligence, which should include speaking with a community college counselor, who is deeply familiar with the transfer process.
