- → What is the status on the Jakarta EE rights to javax package namespace and Java Trademarks? 5/3/19 blog by Mike Milinkkovich. {tweet post} Eclipse Foundation Director, quote: "Eclipse and Oracle have agreed that the javax package namespace cannot be evolved by the Jakarta EE community. As well, Java trademarks such as the existing specification names cannot be used by Jakarta EE specifications."

Commits that are provided by non-committers must have a Signed-off-by field in the footer indicating that the author is aware of the terms by which the contribution has been provided to the project. The non-committer must additionally have an Eclipse Foundation account and must have a signed Eclipse Contributor Agreement (ECA) on file.
