TITLE: Campus Food Pantry Industrial Support Bill

I. Purpose

The purpose of this bill is to help support the Campus Food Pantry (CFP) to empower Boise State students to thrive and increase their overall well-being. Both ASBSU and the CFP are committed to ending hunger in our Boise State community through free resources, advocacy, and education. This piece of legislation will help support much needed infrastructure items that would promote growth and food sourcing for the CFP.

II. Rationale

WHEREAS, ASBSU was and still is an important piece on the success of the Campus Food Pantry and has a duty to ensure the pantry can run efficiently and effectively

WHEREAS, In order to increase CFP staff capacity and allow larger food rescue stores, the CFP needs an industrial floor scale to efficiently and effectively weigh cart loads of donated food products

WHEREAS, In just October 2022, the CFP had over 4,200 student visits. Which was $\frac{1}{3}$ of total visits for the previous academic year in one month.

WHEREAS, The CFP is in need of 1 Low Profile Floor Scale - H754 (\$1,650), 1 Optional Ramp for Floor Scales - H758 - 10,000 lbs (\$610), 3 Floor Scale Bump Guard - H9547 (\$190)

WHEREAS, these prices and materials are through the certified vendors for the CFP and meet certain certifications.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that ASBSU will allocate \$2,830 from the ASBSU Contingency Budget to the Campus Food Pantry account.

III. Provisions

- A. \$2,830 will be drawn from the ASBSU Contingency Budget and transferred to the Campus Food Pantry Account.
- B. The provisions of this bill will go into effect immediately after the passing of this bill.

IV. Fiscal Impact

- A. This Bill will cost \$2,830 and will be drawn from the ASBSU Contingency Budget.
