**Tournament Central & Bathrooms:** Tournament Central will be in main parking lot. There are porta jons onsite there.

**PDGA Live Scoring:** At least one person from each group needs to fill in the PDGA live scoring. To login to live scoring, go to PDGA.com/score and enter the passcode (GG22) If you have more questions, refer to live scoring FAQ on the PDGA.com site.

Player Packs and Vending: <u>Player packs will be distributed on Sunday!</u> I will have a few items at tourney central available for purchase on Saturday, but the disc inventory will not be setup until Sunday.

**Ace Pool:** If no one hits the ace pool, the funds will be donated to the family of Tommy Lane Smith who was a local golfer who was taken from us unexpectedly on May 10th due to a senseless act of violence.

Schedule of Events: May 28-29, 2022

## Saturday:

0800-1300: Round 1 Tee times at Dolly Cooper. Show up and check in 15 minutes before your tee time.

1600-1900: Player/Community Disc Golf Party at Golden Grove Farm & Brew.

- Raffle for a basket and possibly other items. (1 free entry. Opportunity to buy more tickets onsite.)
- 9 hole Par 2 course will be setup going up hole 1 and down hole 5.
- 1025 Putting contest with prizes by rating group for players.

# Sunday:

0900-1400: Round 2 Tee times at Dolly Cooper. Show up 15 minutes before tee time to check in and get your player pack. Cash CTPs in Play on round 2. Also have a special free CTP for the entire field on hole 18 during round 2.

I will distribute prizes by division around the time the last competitor for each division has finished the round. Cash CTPs and ace pool prizes will be sent electronically after the event concludes.

#### **OB and Course Rules**

Make sure you are familiar with the PDGA Competition Manual and Official Rules of Disc Golf. All PDGA rules shall be observed. Any water on course not specified on a hole should be considered casual relief. Any flagged lines will have an arrow at the end to indicate direction of the infinite OB line should your shot extend past the flagged area for some reason. If you need a TD ruling for an issue on the course, you can call my cell or play a provisional and discuss the issue with me after the round **BEFORE YOU TURN IN YOUR SCORES!** 

#### **Dolly Cooper:**

HOLE 1 OB: Baseball field (fence), concrete walking path left of basket and beyond, concrete parking pad on right.

**HOLE 2 OB:** Retention pond (flagged), and concrete walking path and beyond.

**HOLE 3 OB:** Retention pond (flagged), river and beyond (surrounded by water)

HOLE 4 OB: Retention pond (flagged), baseball field (fence), drainage ditch to left (flagged), river and beyond (surrounded by water)

**HOLE 5 OB:** River (surrounded by water and beyond) OB

HOLE 8 OB: Road and beyond

HOLE 9 OB: Baseball field (inside fence)

HOLE 10 OB: Retention pond (stakes/flags), road and beyond, dock and beyond, river and beyond (surrounded by water)

HOLE 12-14 OB: River and beyond (surrounded by water) OB

HOLE 15 OB: Property line fence (long) and beyond

**HOLE 16 OB:** Property line fence (right) and beyond (flagged in gaps)

**HOLE 17 OB:** OB Fence line on right and beyond (flagged in gaps)

**HOLE 18 OB:** Flags define island green. Regular OB rules apply for all shots. Optional drop zone exists between tee box and rock circle around goal (White line marks drop zone). Free CTP for all Divisions
