PROGRAM INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS

- Candidates are encouraged to meet with the Professor-in-Residence to review their professional study plan.
- The prerequisite course, Math 10B or an equivalent is required to enroll in MATH 100.
- Credential coursework must be taken for a letter grade, except those courses that are only offered for Credit/No credit.
- A **3.00 overall GPA** must be maintained throughout the credential coursework.
- No grade lower than a 'C'. Candidates who earn a 'D', 'F', 'W', 'WU' or 'NC' grade in any professional coursework must request a special consideration to retake those courses. This will result in additional semesters to complete the program.
- To enroll in EHD 170, the student must:
 - Complete all Phase 1 coursework with a 3.00 GPA.
 - Meet subject matter competency
 - Possess a valid Certificate of Clearance and TB Risk Assessment.
- Professional Study Plans are subject to change. Notifications to students will be made if necessary.



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ADDITIONAL NOTES

Preliminary Multiple Subject credential application eligibility

- Complete all coursework with a 3.0 GPA [no D or F grades], within ten (10) years prior to applying for your preliminary credential.
- Pass the Fresno Assessment of Student Teachers (FAST)
- CSET scores are valid for a period of ten (10) years. Scores must be valid to apply for the intern or preliminary credential.
- Possess a valid Certificate of Clearance and CPR certificate.
- Pass college-level U.S. Constitution course [with a C or higher] or approved Constitution exam
- Complete Individual Development Plan (IDP)
- To clear the preliminary credential, candidates will complete an Induction Program as advised by the employing district.
