- Social Scientist cross-team research
  - Main contacts: Sue Nolen (OSU), Geoff Herman (UIUC)
  - Social scientists are embedded in teams, with closer site knowledge
  - Brainstorming research topics for cross-team work
    - Team functioning
      - Variation in roles prescribed by NSF
      - Team internal dynamics
      - Team make-up
      - Interaction of these with context/institutional characteristics
    - Social networks or diffusion of technology
    - Team context, department/unit context
    - Processes of change: trust, listening, threat
    - Appropriate/interesting unit of analysis is different for different research questions:
      - Individuals
      - unit/context
- REDCON website

  - REDCON needs a plan for how to have an impact and become national leaders
  - Goal for website: attract implementers
    - For: faculty, staff, researchers, administration
    - Content: what are results, processes, what's been tried
    - Not: outdated

    - Factors relevant to resistance
      - Can you categorize?
    - Who's at the table
