Want to help support the Diversify Dietetics Community? We're currently recruiting for a leadership scholar to support our core programs and the pipeline development of dietitians of color. This includes working with our mentor program, dietetic internship application support (DAS) program, and future RD exam programming. If you have strong project management skills, a passion for the DD community, a sense of creativity, and experience working with students and young professionals this is the role for you!

About us: Diversify Dietetics is a 501c3 nonprofit organization dedicated to increasing the racial and ethnic diversity of the field of nutrition by empowering nutrition leaders of color. We identify barriers that exist to advancing through the field of dietetics and provide a community and supportive solutions.

Position Requirements:

- Credentialed status as a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist
- Candidate who is ethnically diverse in relation to the current field of dietetics
- Five to seven years of relevant experience, particularly related to diversity and inclusion expertise and efforts, education and working with minority/underrepresented groups
- Knowledge of the dietetics pathway

Qualified applicants must have demonstrated experience and expertise in:

- Knowledge of key challenges facing nutrition and dietetics students of diverse backgrounds and cultures
- Collaboration with external partners and organizations
- Passion for advancing the diversity, equity, inclusion, and access in the field of dietetics.
- Experience collecting, analyzing and reporting on data, such as through surveys, interviews and reviewing existing literature and reports
- Experience in presenting the results of monitoring and evaluation, quality improvement or research projects to lay and professional audiences.

Additional skills include:

- Self-motivated with the ability to work and make decisions independently
- Ability to function at a high level and lead this program of work
- Strong leadership, interpersonal and team skills
- Ability to exercise sound judgment and make decisions independently

- Willingness to travel as needed to partner sites, meetings and conferences (once travel is able to safely resume)
- Willingness to participate fully in the expectations of Diversify Dietetics, including project calls and reports, manuscript development and professional presentations
- Availability and commitment to the full-time position beginning late November/early December 2022 for at least one year.

Preferred:

- Advanced degree in nutrition/dietetics, public health or other relevant degree strongly preferred
- Candidates without an advanced degree but with significant, relevant work experience may be considered.
- Member of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics if not currently, financial support will be provided to obtain membership
- Member of NOBIDAN if not currently, financial support will be provided to obtain membership
- Member of Diversify Dietetics if not currently, financial support will be provided to obtain membership
- Experience educating and/or precepting nutrition and dietetics students

Scholar Award

- Diversify Dietetics will provide funding support for the leadership scholar at \$75,000. This includes a health insurance stipend.
- Additional funds will be made available for travel stipends to support work-related travel, including lodging, meals and professional conference fees as well as for continuing education as deemed appropriate by Diversify Dietetics
- Additional benefits (retirement, etc.) are not available for this position.
