

BCLUW Academic Goals, 2024-25

ISASP Math, Language Arts, and Science

BCLUW Elementary

In the 23-24 school year 62.9% were proficient or advanced in the ELA portion of ISASP. The goal for these students in the 24-25 school year is 75% will be proficient or advanced.

Goal met: 78% proficient/advanced

In the 23-24 school year 74% were proficient or advanced in the Math portion of ISASP. The goal for these students in the 24-25 school year is 80% will be proficient or advanced.

Goal met: 89% proficient/advanced

BCLUW Middle School

In the 23-24 school year, four grade levels were above the state average for proficient or advanced in the ELA portion of ISASP. The goal for 24-25 is to have all grades at or above the state level for percentage of students proficient or advanced.

For the 24-25 school year, three of the four grades were above the state average for proficient or advanced. Goal not met.

In the 23-24 school year three grade levels were above the state average for proficient or advanced in the Math portion of the ISASP. The goal for 24-25 is to have all grades at or above the state level for percentage of students proficient or advanced.

For the 24-25 school year, three of the four grades were above the state average for proficient or advanced. Goal not met.

In 2023-24, 58% of 5th grade students were proficient in science. The state average is 59% proficient. The 2024-25 science goal is for 5th-grade student proficiency to exceed 60%.
