#### Hello Scituate High School Families,

Below are details pertaining to our PSAT10 & SAT Testing Day at Scituate High School.

- All 11th grade students will participate in the school day SAT on Tuesday, April 8th.
- All 10th grade students will participate in the school day PSAT on Tuesday, April 8th.

### Tuesday, April 8th:

All 10th and 11th grade students will arrive to school no later than 7:45 AM

All students will be dismissed at 12:30 PM and may be picked up or can take their typical bus

#### **Lunch and Snacks**

The College Board builds in scheduled breaks. Students will be provided with snacks and water during these breaks. **Students should bring a bagged lunch OR they can purchase a box lunch after testing.** Students may also bring their own water or snacks if they prefer, but will not be allowed to eat them in class.

## Below are some important reminders for testing

- All testers should bring a fully charged chromebook and a charger
- Students should reboot their chromebook in the morning once they arrive to class
- <u>Bluetooth headsets are not allowed (unless approved by school/CollegeBoard)</u>
- Students should arrive at school on time, well-rested, and should also eat a good breakfast
- Students will be given short breaks throughout the day however, the test will take about three hours to complete
- Students should not bring backpacks, cell phones, personal electronic devices, or smart watches into the testing classroom
