### Meeting Overview

The BBSC January 2026 Board Meeting covered several key points. Matthew Heffernan is the new Board President, with Ronnie Moore now newly elected as Vice President of Baseball and Sue Ellis newly elected as Vice President of Softball. Longtime Board President Chad Runge is now the Treasurer. The treasury report revealed a balance of \$107,867. Registrations are up nearly 15% of previous year. The board discussed the travel coach training update, emphasizing relationship building and resource availability. Mandatory training for travel coaches remains a policy, and the new Board President will be setting up a meeting to meet all travel coaches in before the Spring Season. Registration status highlighted a potential issue with the 14U youth softball team, currently at 12 registered players. Uniforms were approved, with softball jerseys finalized and a one-week window for change requests. Field maintenance plans were outlined, including inspections and potential dirt needs for various fields. Mike Leach was unanimously voted in as the 2<sup>nd</sup> of three Baseball Representatives (Brad Snodgrass being the other current rep). Joe Healy was introduced as the new Webmaster for the league. Two of the biggest youth sports serving organizations on the Broadneck Peninsula (BBSC and BAYS) are in the middle of negotiations to potentially merge into one organization.
