

Abstract consist of maximum 200-250 words and consist of one paragraph that contains research's objectives, method, and research findings. Introduction: it should consist of 2-3 sentences about research background and a sentence about objective of the research. Method: it contains research design, research place setting, sample, dependent and independent variables, how to measure the variables, and techniques on data analysis. Result: it contains the main result of the research.*

**Keywords:** *it consists of maximum 5 words/ phrases. Each word or phrase is separated with coma.*

### **Abstrak**

Abstrak terdiri dari 200-250 kata, memuat uraian singkat mengenai masalah dan tujuan penelitian, metode yang digunakan, dan hasil penelitian. Tekanan penulisan abstrak terutama pada hasil penelitian. Abstrak ditulis dalam bahasa Indonesia dan Bahasa Inggris. Pengetikan abstrak dilakukan dengan spasi tunggal dengan margin yang lebih sempit dari margin kanan dan kiri teks utama. ## **INTRODUCTION**

Introduction contains background, rationale, and research urgency. References or related studies need to be included in this part. It relates to justification of research urgency, the appearance of research problem, solution alternatives, and the chosen solution. The author needs to write clearly about the author's names and citation sources includes the year of publication and the page where the article is cited. Problem, objectives, and benefits of the research are written narratively in paragraphs. It doesn't need specific sub-title. Besides, operational definition also must be written if it is necessary. Introduction is written with Times New Roman, font size 12 upright, 1,5 space. Each paragraph started with word which is 1,1 cm from the left edge of each column.

## **METHOD**

This method is written in descriptive and should provide a statement regarding the methodology of the research. This method to give as much as possible an idea to the reader through the methods used, contains a discussion of the approach method, research specifications, types and techniques of data collection, and data analysis methods.

## **RESULT AND DISCUSSION**

### **Research Finding**

Research finding and discussion consist of two sub-chapters and discussion. There are separated sub-title and discussion as found at this template. Articles may contain tables and or figures. Table and figure are made simple, not too big and not too much. They should be written using Times New Roman, font size 12, and single space. Here is the example of table:

Table should be written in the middle or at the end of every description text. Besides, this chapter may contain figures, diagrams, or graphics.

## **Discussion**

Discussion contains description and explanation from the research finding which is done comprehensively. If there are or the same as 4 lines or more than 50 words, so it should be jutting in with single space. The references on article body and references should be written based on American Psychological Association (APA) style.

## **CONCLUSION**

Closing consists of conclusion from the research finding done before. Conclusion may be a finding generalization based on research problem. Besides, it can be recommendation for the next steps. It can be suggestion for the next researchers. It also can be implicative recommendation from the research findings.

## **REFERENCES**

The bibliography in research articles and conceptual ideas contains all the references used in the study. References that may be referenced are published in the last 10 (ten) years, except for certain references (books) that have not been republished in the last 10 years. The composition of the bibliography is highly recommended in the form of primary sources (80%) namely national journals, international journals, theses, dissertations, conference proceedings both nationally and internationally. Other sources (20%) can be books or other reference sources.

References are written at the end of closing which refer to American Psychological Association (APA) style. Those should be written with single space (12 pt). Here are the examples of writing references with Mendeley:
