Privacy Policy

1. Overview

PageSnap Pro ("the Extension") is a Chrome browser extension that allows users to capture full-page screenshots of webpages and save them as PNG images or PDF documents. This Privacy Policy explains our data practices and your rights as a user.

We are committed to protecting your privacy. The short version: we collect nothing, store nothing, and share nothing.

2. Data We Collect

PageSnap Pro does not collect, transmit, store, or share any personal data or user information of any kind. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Browsing history or URLs of pages you visit
- Screenshots or images captured using the Extension
- Personal identifiers such as name, email, IP address, or device ID
- Usage analytics or telemetry data
- Cookies or tracking information

All screenshot processing is performed entirely locally within your browser. No data ever leaves your device.

3. Permissions Used and Why

The Extension requests the following Chrome permissions solely to perform its core functionality:

activeTab — Used to access the currently open tab for the purpose of capturing its content.

scripting — Used to inject scroll scripts into the active tab to read page dimensions and scroll through the full page during capture.

tabs — Used to read the tab's window ID and call the Chrome screenshot API.

downloads — Used to save the captured PNG or PDF file to the user's local device.

host_permissions — Required to operate across any website the user chooses to capture, since the target site is not known in advance.

None of these permissions are used for data collection, advertising, tracking, or any purpose beyond capturing and saving screenshots.

4. Local Processing Only

All operations performed by PageSnap Pro take place entirely on your device:

- Screenshots are rendered in-memory in your browser using the HTML5 Canvas API.
- PDF files are generated locally using the bundled jsPDF library — no external server is contacted.
- Saved files are written directly to your device via the Chrome Downloads API.
- No network requests are made by the Extension itself.

5. Third-Party Services

PageSnap Pro does not integrate with, communicate with, or share data with any third-party services, analytics platforms, advertising networks, or remote servers.

The jsPDF library used for PDF generation is bundled locally within the extension package and operates entirely offline.

6. Remote Code Execution

PageSnap Pro does not execute any remote code. All JavaScript is bundled within the extension package at install time. No code is fetched, downloaded, or executed from external sources at runtime.

7. Children's Privacy

PageSnap Pro does not knowingly collect any information from anyone, including children under the age of 13. Since no data is collected by the Extension, it does not present any privacy risk to users of any age.

8. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. Any changes will be reflected by updating the Effective Date at the top of this document. We encourage you to review this policy periodically. Continued use of the Extension after changes constitutes acceptance of the updated policy.
