

2023 Maple Grove Fishing Team Intrasquad Tournament Rules

- Anglers fish as teams.
- Only artificial lures are allowed during competition.
- Fishing will be limited to the hours of 7:00 am - 2:00 pm local time. All fish photos must be submitted by 2:00 pm.
- During official competition (i.e. morning take-off until the boat is out of the water), anytime the combustion engine is running, anglers **MUST BE** seated with life jackets on and buckled.
- If wearing an inflatable life jacket, the inflatable life jacket **MUST BE** worn at **ALL TIMES** during the tournament.
- All practice pre-fishing must cease by 8:00 pm local time prior to the day of the tournament.

Official Recording/Reporting Procedure

- Winning totals will be based on “total length” recorded by a team.
- There is a **7 Fish limit**. The best 7 fish will count toward your total.
- Once a fish is caught, place the fish on a “bump board” and a photo via the **Time Stamp** app. The photo should contain the entire fish and bump board. Tails may be pinched. Lengths will be rounded up to the nearest ¼ inch.
- Send the picture to **612-790-9140**, and it will be recorded on the Official Scoresheet.
- Pictures must clear and the team name must accompany the photo.
- Ties will be broken by the longest fish length.

Prizes will be awarded to the team that has:

- First “legal” fish
- Last “legal” fish
- Least Number of “legal” fish
- Shortest Total Length of combined “legal” fish
- Largest Number of “legal” fish
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall with the longest total length of fish

****Legal fish is defined as “a largemouth or smallmouth bass with a length longer than 12” that is recorded through the official recording procedures and is caught between the hours of 7:00 am and 2:00 pm local time.”****
