In his paper, Nakamoto introduced a “purely peer-to-peer” electronic cash system in the form of Bitcoin¹, a revolutionary technological advancement in many rights. Academic Value Exchange (AVE) Service: Updates

eUtopium's AVE Service is a fully crowdfunded and crowdsourced community project, financed by the *eUtopium Education Fund* and managed by the *Utopia Project*. For background information about [eUtopium \(UPM\)](#) and our AVE Service, [please read here](#).

The AVE service is now fully functional! Anyone from all over the world may now **submit their past academic work in exchange for monetary value** in the form of UPMs. UPM is a cryptographic currency created by the Utopia Project, based on the Bitcoin Protocol, honoring values such as decentralization, distribution, security, and stability which are at the core of its design.

By submitting their papers, academics will have their related and approved work added to the Utopia Project's ever-growing library of truth and knowledge, which may be utilized in the future by the UPM community to create value for eUtopium and its associated projects, and ultimately for the cryptocurrency ecosystem as a whole and its community at large.

The AVE service is designed and built with **simplicity** at its core, in a bid to cater to mainstream users, or non-adopters of cryptocurrency. In addition to the submission page that has now been made available to the public, there are also accompanying beginner's guides which will provide them with an accessible point of entry into cryptocurrency self-education, such as eBooks, weblinks, videos, and other useful resources that will help new users familiarize themselves with the Bitcoin and Altcoin landscape, while teaching them how to navigate around this new and seemingly complex world of digital money; free magic internet money.

UPM AVE Service: How does it work?

The AVE service has launched with a *price-per-page* model of value exchange, where **one** page of academic work can be exchanged for **10 UPMs**, at a maximum of **300 UPMs** per submission. The page count will only be triggered by pages with relevant content, not including any cover pages, the contents page, appendices, and extra erroneous spaces. For a start, approval of submissions and payment disbursements will be managed on a manual basis, until a practical solution is developed to automate the entire process. All approved papers added to our repository will receive UPMs in exchange for value.

Enter Utopia: Instructions for Value Exchange

At this current point in time, we will only be collecting academic or whitepapers written about the following topics, or any mixture of these and topics that may be related to your context:

- Cryptocurrency (non-technical) economics and ecosystems
- Marketing
 - Online Marketing - Organic Marketing, SEO
 - Branding
 - Brand Loyalty
 - Customer Relationship Management
- Social Media
 - Customer Participation and User Motivations
 - Crowdsourcing and User Generated Content
 - Big Data and Data Analytics

If you submit papers not related to topics said above (subjected to admin approval), you will be contacted by an admin who will give feedback and provide suggestions for changes to make it suitable for the UPM educational and academic repository. After editing, you may submit your paper again through the AVE service to restart the verification process. Once verified and approved, your paper will be added to the repository, and your UPMs will be dispersed to the

Research Questions

 - a. Based on Satoshi's paper, and considering the current landscape of the bit/altcoin ecosystems as whole.
2. Who are the stakeholders involved in any cryptocurrency?
3. What are the biggest barriers to entry for current non-adopters of cryptocurrency?
4. In your opinion, what are the most innovative features in crypto that currently exist?
5. What factors affect the success of a cryptocurrency? What makes an altcoin popular?
6. What is the end goal / are the next steps for cryptocurrency?
 - a. Satoshi started an era decentralization, but what's next?

- b. The Internet brought knowledge & information, Bitcoin brought money & financial freedom, what's next?
7. What should the community do to increase crypto adoption among mainstream users?

Rules

I have none but three rules for you:

1. Begin your paper with: "I am..."
2. End the same sentence/paragraph with "...on this earth."
3. Refer to people as "humans".

After completing your paper, submit them through the AVE service on our website, and wait for an admin to get back to you. When submitting your paper for this contest, please add "eUEF" to the front of your paper name.

All papers submitted may be added into the eUtopium educational repository, our ever-expanding library of knowledge and truth. If added, you will receive 10 UPMs per page in value exchange, as per the AVE service. However, not all papers added will receive a part of the prize pool.

The contest starts today, and ends 6 days from now, on the 10th of August, 2014. All papers must be submitted before then to qualify for a potential payout from the prize pool. All papers submitted before this announcement also qualify. [Find all uploaded papers here.](#)
