

STEAMFest 2023 MATH CONTEST

Millburn students of K-12 can sign up for our Math Contest where they'll be able to put their mathematical problem solving skills to work!

Tournament: Saturday, April 20, 2024

Time/Format: Grades K-1: [10 am - 12 pm] in-person contest

> Grades 2-3: [10 am - 12 pm] in-person contest Grades 4-5: [2:30 - 3:30 pm] online contest Middle School: [3:30 - 4:30 pm] online contest High School: [4:30 - 5:30 pm] online contest

This tournament is open to all Millburn residents in grades K-12. **Eligibility:**

Levels: **Level 1:** Grades K-1 (40 min duration)

> Level 2: Grades 2-3 (40 min duration) **Level 3:** Grades 4-5 (45 min duration) **Level 4:** Middle School (45 min duration) Level 5: High School (45 min duration)

Prizes: Level 1 Grades K-2:

> 1st place - \$25 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement and a Trophy 2nd place - \$15 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement and a Trophy 3rd place - \$10 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement and a Trophy

4th and 5th place - Honorable mentions and a medal

Level 2 Grades 3-5 and **Level 3** Grades 6-8:

1st place - \$50 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement and a Trophy 2nd place - \$35 Gift Card. Certificate of Achievement and a Trophy 3rd place - \$25 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement and a Trophy

4th and 5th place - Honorable mentions and a medal

Level 4 Grades 9-12:

1st place - \$75 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement 2nd place - \$60 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement 3rd place - \$40 Gift Card, Certificate of Achievement

4th and 5th place - Honorable mentions

If there is a tie at the end of the contest, students included in the tie will evenly split the related prize money pool. For example, if two students in Level 3 Grades 6-8 tie for 1st



place, we will combine the prize money meant for top 2 students and split it. So each would receive \$42.50 and the next placed student would get \$25.

Location: Grades K-2 and 3-5 contests will be conducted at the Washington School Multi Purpose

Room. We request you drop off the children 15 minutes before the contest start time and

wait in your car or the designated waiting room until the contest is over.

Grades 6-8 and 9-12 contests will take place virtually. The students will receive the link to a Zoom meeting. The link to the online contest will be given at the beginning of the Zoom meeting. Students will be expected to keep their cameras on during the meeting

and exit only after submitting their form.

Fair Play: By registering, all students agree not to use outside assistance of any kind.
