# colore lce breaker(s) - Choose 1 or 2

- Take 3-5 minutes in pairs to meet and get to know one other person here, then introduce them to the group, using what you learned about them.
- Who did you idolize as a child? How did you imitate them in your life?
- If you had to quarantine at home for one month, who would you like to have there with you 24/7? (Can be no one, multiple people, people from history...)

# Read Ephesians 4:22-31 and 5:1-4

- Why do you think God cares so deeply about the way we treat each other?
- How do you think we can allow the Spirit to change our thoughts and attitudes? (Eph. 4:22)
- How has God helped you "throw off" old ways of relating to others? How has this allowed you to relate better with others?
- Pastor Andy said "You become what you behold," and "You are the sum total of the top 5 people you spend time with." How are your inputs -- what you see or hear -- affecting your ability to love like Jesus does? How do your top 5 people influence your standard of loving others?

### More Questions To Consider

- Given the division present in our culture today, how can followers of Jesus be different as they relate to others? What difference would it make?
- (Optional) Which of the "Don't" behaviors listed in these verses are the hardest for you to overcome in your life -- lying, anger, stealing, laziness, foul/abusive language, bitterness, sexual immorality, greed, ...? Share one thing you think God would want you

- personally to remove from the way you relate to others, and one thing He would want you to add, so that you relate better to others?
- What would you like to change about how you relate to someone important in your life? Share one concrete step you will take this week to help you get there.
