Project Description :

A good ambiance for a dining place is not that much to ask. Especially if it holds every individual who only seeks the progress and pride of their employer, in everyday dwellings. This perspective just makes both the institution and the workers'

life worthwhile, inspiring, and thriving. Change, on the other hand, maybe one of the significant forces to attain such an endeavor.

The University Cafeteria is part of the institutional student programs and services of the Student Affairs and Services (SAS) of the campus. It ensures available, adequate, safe and healthful food within the campus and immediate vicinity. It caters students, faculty, and staff of the university, as well as guests of the university and the community.

For USTP-Claveria, its environment is at a fast pace of development in terms of academic and infrastructural aspects. The number of enrollees is increasing in that it demands spacious and decent dining place. The advancement of either of these essential elements for this institute is being attempted and discussed daily. Recently, an Ad Hoc Committee for the Cafeteria Development and Management was created by the Campus Chancellor to evaluate or assess the school cafeteria in all aspects like infrastructure, sanitation, and among others. In their initial report, per assessment on the status of the cafeteria structure (building), it urge to remodel the old USTP Claveria Cafeteria into a State-of-the-Art Food Court. Cafeteria is an important facility in every institution, being one of the student services and an income generating project. It is everybody's knowledge how important the cafeteria to us and in this institution and not just a cafeteria like this (the old one) but the institution deserves to have a decent food court where we can be proud of and boost to our stakeholders and visitors, hence, this proposal.

The said rebuilding covers the entirety of the present situation of the said premise for the canteen is more or less half a century old. But it is one of the campus' operational and profiting facilities. Nevertheless, it is currently bound with venerable components such as roof, wood roof truss, dry and masonry walls, floor, kitchen, doors, windows, etc. They also have poor sanitation practices due to limited accessibility and undeveloped terrain. The electrical and water supply, on the other hand, are still working, though its orientation is cluttered.

The **University of Science and Technology of Southern Philippines (USTP)-Claveria** now invites bids for the **Construction of USTP-Claveria Food Center** of USTP-Claveria at Poblacion, Claveria, Misamis Oriental. Completion of the Works is required **One Hundred Eighty (180) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed**. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."
- Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or corporations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from **University of Science and Technology of Southern Philippines (USTP) - Claveria** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the given address below at **8:00 AM to 5:00 PM** weekdays.

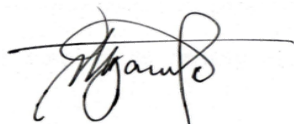
