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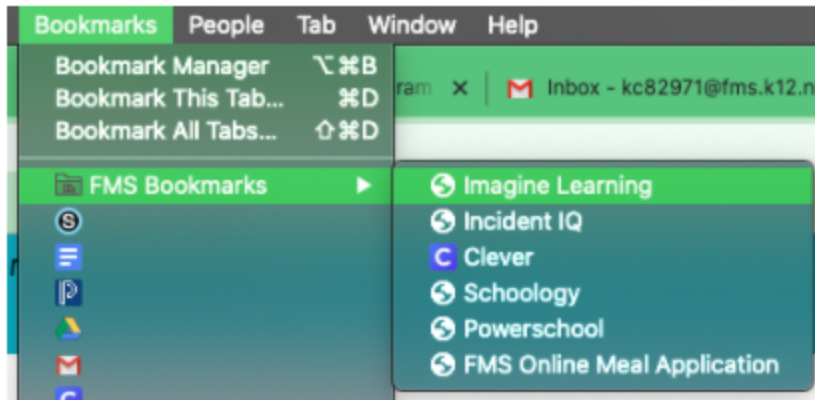

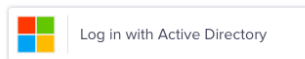

How to install the Clever Extension

- 1.) Go to: <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/category/extensions>
- 2.) Click on the FMS Apps Collection
- 3.) Find the Clever extension and select it, then click the blue button "Add to Chrome".

The extension will appear in the upper right corner of the browser window.



Click on the extension to log into Clever. You may have to do the full login using the Active Directory option, but after that, clicking the extension should take you straight in.

How students join a Zoom meeting from a link

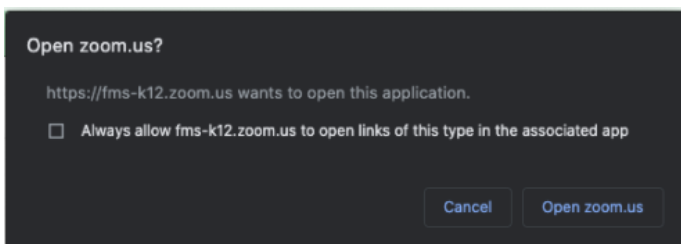
Students, check that you have the Zoom app in Finder or in the Launchpad.



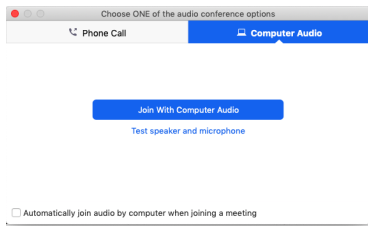
If you don't see the app, leave your computer open and the app will appear. *It could take a few hours.

To enter a meeting using your Zoom app: You will receive a link from your teacher. The link could be in Schoology, Clever or in your Google calendar.

- 1.) Click on the link.
- 2.) The link will open a pop-up window like below.



- 3.) Click on the **checkbox** to "Always allow fms-k12.zoom.us to open links..."
- 4.) Then click on **"Open zoom.us"**.
- 5.) When the teacher admits you into the room, you will need to join with computer audio.

Technology Office Support Information

With the implementation of the district Continuous Learning Plan starting on April 13 we know that keeping our computers functional will be more important than ever. In order to better accommodate our users FMS will provide tech support services.

1. In-person tech support: Monday-Friday 12:00 PM - 4:00 PM at District Office.

In all cases when staff or students require tech support, you must follow the standard procedures for requesting assistance:

1. **Create a support ticket in our Technology Helpdesk, <https://fms.incidentiq.com>. Students or parents can sign-in using the student's normal computer login information. This is the preferred method of requesting support.**
2. **Call the Technology Office at 505-599-8820 and leave a message. Please include your name and/or the student's name and school, and a callback number or e-mail address.**

If your computer problem is so severe that it cannot be solved remotely, we will set up an appointment for you to bring the laptop in for service during in-person tech support hours. You will get more detailed instructions on computer drop-off at the point when the problem requires it.

We are trying to abide by social distancing recommendations so please do not come to the District Office for tech support unless you have created a ticket or called the Tech office ahead of time. This allows us to better control the process and number of people present at any one time.

Laptop Care Guidelines

Make sure you charge your laptop every night!

Cleaning Your Laptop:

- Completely power off your laptop (Shut down)
- Gently wipe down the screen with an Electronic Cleaning Wipe, or lightly damp rag. Make sure the rag will not drop any water when squeezed before using on the computer.
- Wipe carefully across the keyboard and the trackpad
- Clean top and bottom of outside case

Most Common Damage on Laptops Caused by:

- Drops

Tips to Limit Damage:

- Keep your laptop in a safe place (Not on floor, bed or any place it can easily be knocked off or stepped on, preferably away from small children and/or animals)
- Laptops that are stored or used on the ground (dirt, grass, etc.) will most likely cause damage to the laptop
- Always ensure that laptop has proper airflow (Do not block the air vents and keep any small objects away from all air vents)
- Keep all liquids away from your laptop
