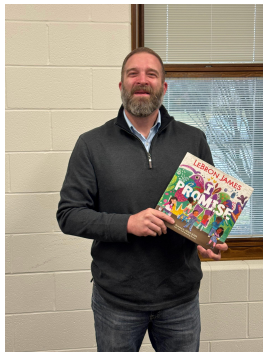

COUNSELOR'S CORNER

STAR Character Trait (March)-Respect

This month we will focus on defining the word respect and what it looks like in different areas in the student's lives (i.e. at school, home, in the community).

Modeling Leadership Through Respect: Parenting Tips

- ☐ **Listen Actively**
Give your full attention when your child speaks.
Avoid interrupting or dismissing their feelings, even if they seem minor to you.
Say things like, "I hear you" or "Tell me more about that."
- ☐ **Speak Calmly and Kindly**
Use a respectful tone, even when correcting behavior: "Let's talk about a better way to handle that," instead of "What's wrong with you?"
- ☐ **Set Clear, Respectful Boundaries**
Be firm, but fair. Explain rules and the reasons behind them.
Example: "We clean up after ourselves because we share this space."
- ☐ **Apologize When You're Wrong**
"I was frustrated and shouldn't have raised my voice. I'm sorry."
This teaches kids that everyone makes mistakes and how to repair them.
- ☐ **Encourage Two-Way Communication**
Let your child express opinions, even if you disagree.
