

Who can post to a bConnected List?

List settings for who can post	Why choose this option?
Managers of the bConnected List – automatically reject postings from non-Managers	<p>This setting automatically rejects postings from anyone who is not a list manager. This setting works best when list managers need to retain control over the list and do not want list subscribers to be able to send to the list.</p> <p>This is the <i>most</i> restrictive setting available in bConnected Lists.</p>
Members of the bConnected List – automatically reject postings from non-members	<p>This setting automatically rejects postings from anyone who is not a list subscriber. This works best when the list manager does not want to actively manage posts from the subscribers, but still restricts non-members from posting.</p>
<p>Members only - held for moderation (default)</p> <p>This became the default option effective 10/24/2016.</p>	<p>Held for Manager approval; this setting will allow members to post to the list and will require a list manager to approve/deny any messages that come from non-members. A list manager can always approve and then choose to “trust” future messages from those non-members.</p>
Members; plus everyone with a bConnected Google account (faculty, students, staff, alumni & retirees)	<p>This setting allows any UC Berkeley bConnected account holder to send to the list. If you wish your list to be open and unrestricted to the Berkeley community this is a good option for you.</p>
Public: anyone in the world	<p>This setting allows anyone in the world to post to your list. This is a good option if your list is truly public and list managers are not concerned with restricting</p>

	communication to only bConnected account holders.
