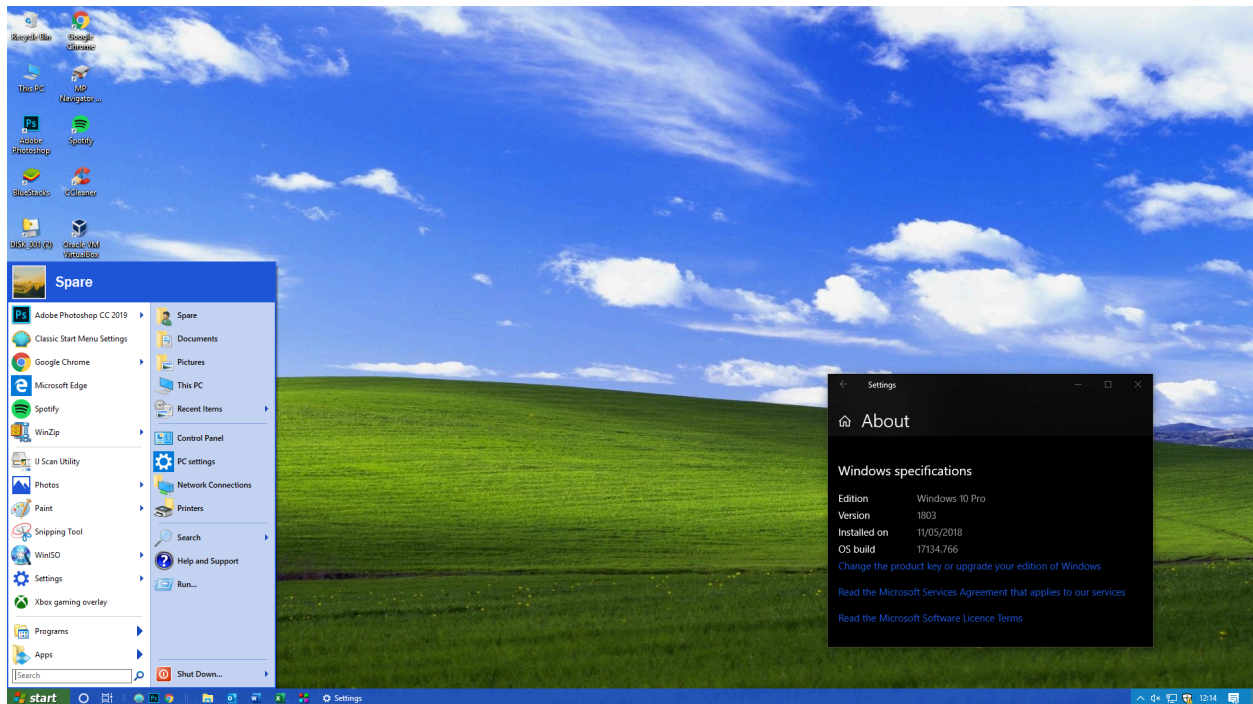


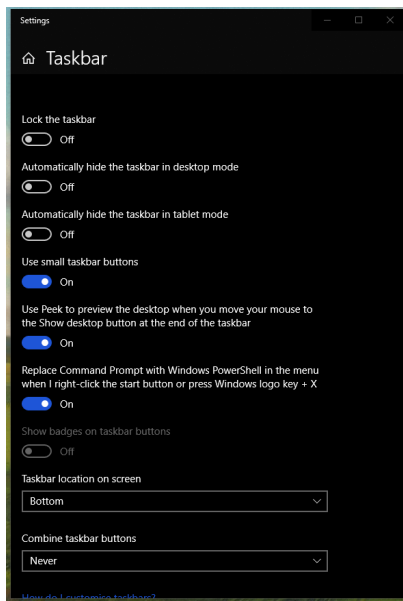
How to make you Windows 10 look like a modern Windows XP (Because why not)



Resource Dump: - All the assets you need are here

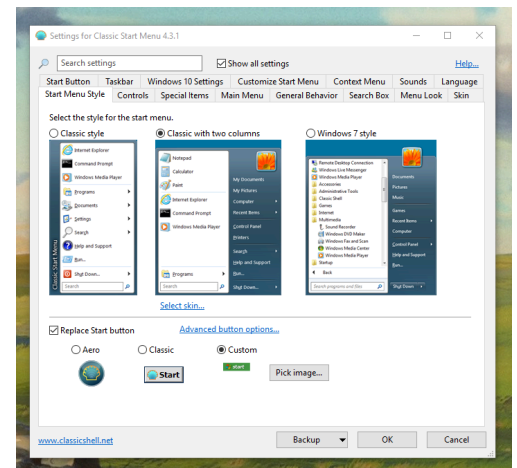

1. Open Windows Taskbar Settings and make sure they match the following;

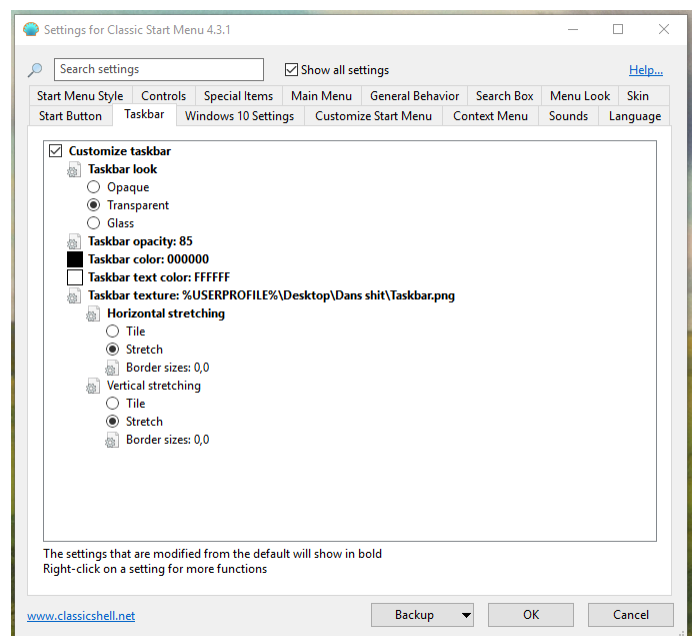


(Small Taskbar icons and Combining Taskbar buttons are the important ones)

2. Install Classic Shell and launch it
3. In the Start Menu Style tab, tick the box labeled “Replace Start button”
4. Tick custom and select “Pick Image” and use the image called “Start” from the resource dump

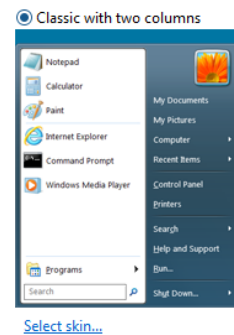


5. Next select the “Taskbar” tab and set the “Taskbar Texture” to the corresponding file from the resource dump and replicate the settings shown here



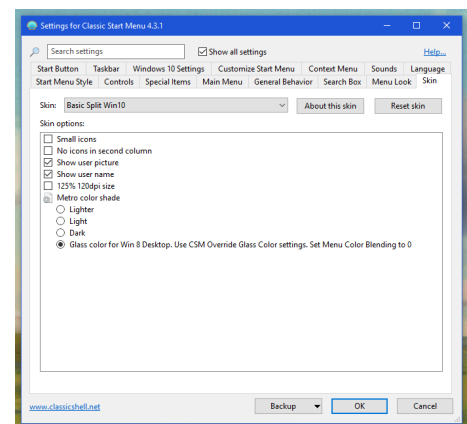
6. To set up the start menu you have to place the file called “Basic Split Win10.skin” file from the dump into this Directory
C:\Program Files\Classic Shell\Skins

7. Then back in Classic shell return to the “Start Menu Style” tab and select the option for “Classic with two columns” then press “Select Skin” below that



8. On the page you are brought to select “Basic Split Win10” from the drop down list and tick “Show User Picture” & “Show User Name”

9. You can do additional tweaks and what not in the “Menu Look” tab I can't remember all the changes I did but change to your heart's content.



10. Change your Windows metro theme colour to the one in the “Colour Information.txt” file to have the matching blue border around your selected tabs.

11. Additionally you can set up a toolbar on your Taskbar to get something similar to the old quick launch icons. (Google this one it's pretty simple)
