

Summarized Game Premise

Melodies of Eternity was a panfandom rp game based heavily on the Final Fantasy franchise and was created as a sequel to the rp game Melodies of Life. In MoE, characters arrived with no powers and are allowed to pick up Jobs to gain abilities. Jobs were magical roles that a character could gain by going to separate guilds (including Black Mage, Gunslinger, Summoner, etc. from the Final Fantasy games). Characters appeared in a nebula in the sky called the Dream Width and were picked up in an airship by NPCs Biggs Darklighter and Wedge Antilles.

The planet characters lived on was named Vaikuntha, not the same planet that existed in MoL, Crystallis. Different NPC races populated the world with their own governments, laws, etc. Also populating the world were ancient, powerful beings known as Eidolons. Characters who took the Summoner Job were able to pray to Eidolons to gain their favor and potentially use their strength in battle.

Characters were brought through the Dream Width purposefully, chosen carefully by an unknown source, and dubbed the Heroes of Light who would fight against the Calamity that was destined to destroy all of creation. In MoL, characters defeated the goddess Kalki who used the Calamity for her own gain. Now, with more Heroes finally returning, their purpose and reason for being there was initially kept a mystery...

Finn arrived during the second month after MoE opened. The game itself ran for about a year and a half.

Finn's Timeline

June 2018

Finn arrived in Vaikuntha directly from the end of *The Last Jedi*. He recognizes Wedge Antilles and agrees to not tell Biggs Darklighter about his own death during *A New Hope*.

Wary of the more magical jobs, Finn picks up **GUNSLINGER** since he has the most experience with those types of weapons and **CHEMIST** to have a support/healing role. He stays in the free housing for about a week before moving into his own home in the quiet farming village, Nakagawa, where he worked with the local police force. His moogles companion, Valli, claims a room for herself.

Event: Finn entered the Golsaucian Gauntlet in the hopes of winning an airship in case any of his friends arrived. After passing the first few trials with no problem, he ends up covered in syrup and barraged by gym equipment. He makes it to the very end but is pushed out of the way by dancing

moogles as the door closed right in front of him. From this point forward, he had a vendetta against syrup. He also got “mugged” by three Hypellos before the game show started.

Event: Finn teamed up with a group of other heroes to fix the flooding problem in Ka’Pandol. Upon reaching the center, the team finds out that Leviathan, not Ultros, is the real Eidolon of Water. They are attacked by Leviathan, and Finn doesn’t trust the Eidolon afterwards. He took up for Ultros which... was a mistake.

July 2018

Azusa, a good friend of Finn’s, gets lost somewhere in Vaikuntha. He embarks on a wild goose chase to track her down.

Event: There’s a killer at a camp retreat. Finn teams up with other Heroes to find the killer before they strike again. They find the serial killing moogle and begin their assault. Just as the moogle is about to kill Castor, Finn used his final shot to kill the moogle. It was amazing.

After the killer was dealt with, a lot of heroes decided to go for a real camping trip. Finn made a lot of friends here.

August 2018

The Empire, a country that has kept its borders closed since before Finn arrived, opens its borders to welcome the heroes. They put on a festival throughout the whole city, offer more Jobs, and invite the heroes to a dinner with the Empress herself.

Finn picks up **ARCHAEOLOGIST** while in the city. While studying a mural of the Eidolons, Finn’s approached by a mysterious man named Meghammal. He’s the first to mention the beings Bahamut, the Master Summoner, and the Goddess of Death. Later, Finn also picks up a kitten and names them Pancake, as that’s the only thing he knew how to cook at the time.

While meeting up with Azusa, he discovered the joy of trash romance novels and started a collection.

At the dinner with the Empress with the other heroes, Finn discovers that Meghammal is one of the right hands of the Empress. She reveals to the heroes that the world is coming to an end by the following April. The Master Summoner will summon Bahamut and destroy them all. She asks the heroes to search for the Summoner as they prepare the summoning and stop them at all costs, also revealing that they were brought to Vaikuntha for that very purpose.

September 2018

With the reveals still upsetting the heroes, Finn calls for a meeting where everyone, including NPCs, can get together and make a plan. Valli called the event CopCon and called in a DJ, kegs, and pizza. After an angry tirade and just giving in to the fun, Finn woke the next morning spooning a plant.

Event: Ganeshan is working on putting together Custom Jobs, roles that heroes can create from scratch. Finn volunteered to be a test subject for the new roles. He aided Okuyasu, Takeshi (Riku AU), and Regis.

Okuyasu’s job made cats mob him. It wasn’t fun but he ended up making a great friend. Takeshi’s job focused on dark powers. This was Finn’s first experience with how strong the dark side can

be as an ally. Upon meeting up with Regis, he realized that his friend had been “canon updated” and was now over twice his age. The meeting was surreal but heartfelt.

October 2018

Finn mastered **GUNSLINGER!**

Event: The heroes hear about some strange happenings going on around Vaikuntha about ghosts. Finn and Ena take on a ghost in an abandoned mansion and end up bonding. With another group, they end up tangling with a Mimic while tracking a ghost. The mimic very nearly bests them. At the end of the fight, they won a trading card...

Event: Rumors spread of an Eidolon in the Sakura Forest. Finn embarks with a team and comes across a camp filled with dead bodies and several mimics. They manage to fight their way out but lose the trail of the Eidolon for good.

November 2018

The heroes decide to work together to secure the four Legendary Eidolons. If Bahamut is summoned (and the search for the Master Summoner is dry thus far), then they're the only ones that can stop the end of the world.

Event: The first stop was Mad'ni Shrine. The ancient shrine/tower proved to be a puzzle of various floors. Finn embarks with a group to search for a better way in, but he's attacked by a tentacled monster. After getting it to release him and pushing the monster back, the heroes do their job and leave the shrine. Finn didn't stay to see if the Eidolon was found.

Event: The second stop was the Uncharted Territories to the north where an Eidolon supposedly stayed. While taking shelter from the weather at Armstrong Fort, Finn uses his healing abilities to help the injured soldiers through the night instead of resting for the expedition. They rewarded him with a dagger that caused fire damage. On the expedition, the team is quickly attacked. Though they win the initial fight, the expedition as a whole was a failure.

Event: The third stop was the Crystal Temple in the Empire, said to be Bahamut's temple. In the temple, the group finds a picture of a hero from Crystallis, the world before Vaikuntha, and a map of Vaikuntha where they believe more Eidolons are located. The rest of the temple proved to be empty.

December 2018

With the situation becoming increasingly tense, Finn picked up **SUMMONER** and gathered **Ramuh**, the Eidolon of Thunder, and **Titan**, the Eidolon of Earth, to his team.

During the Starlight celebration, Finn receives an antique hand cannon from Red during a Secret Santa exchange. He also receives Luke Skywalker's lightsaber by some mysterious means. He takes lessons from Baiken and masters from the Empire to learn how to use the lightsaber with his Summoner job, which is otherwise mostly defenseless.

Event: With the end of the world imminent and no Summoner or Legendary Eidolons found, Finn plots an expedition back through the Dream Width (the nebula in the sky where characters arrive) in the hopes of securing an evacuation route. Most of the heroes, including Biggs and Wedge, go with him on the expedition he leads.

After three days of fighting and travelling through the Dream Width, the heroes emerge in another realm controlled by an ethereal being referred to as the Entity or Cloud of Darkness. Finn steps in front of the group and asks that they be let through to the other side. The Entity tortures him while the others are helpless to watch. It explains that it doesn't care if Bahamut is summoned or they die or any of it. The Entity spreads out Finn's pain to the others and sends them instantly back to Vaikuntha.

Upon waking, everyone on the expedition realized they were given a job called **CALAMITY KNIGHT** that is very powerful but steeped in darkness. Everyone seeks Ganeshan's help to get rid of it except for Finn, who keeps the job in secret.

January 2019

Finn spent most of the month secluded away, healing and isolating himself from his friends.

Event: An intruder invades Mognet central. The swordsman hides himself in the shipping and receiving where Finn and a group of others attack. The swordsman is so odd and skilled, that he gets away.

Event: Still searching for the Legendary Eidolons, they search the I.B. Magitek Tower. Finn's group is attacked by Machina, and he doesn't discover if the others found the Eidolon or not.

February 2019

Finn mastered **CHEMIST!**

With the new arrivals comes two people from Finn's home, though it was no one he expected.

The first arrival was a Zabrak man who called himself Maul and claimed to be a Jedi from the Republic who witnessed the Empire rise to power. After talking for a bit, Maul agreed to train Finn with his lightsaber.

The second arrival was BB-8! Though Finn didn't understand binary, he was extremely excited and relieved to find one of his friends from home.

Despite the highs of seeing people from home, depression hit Finn hard during this month. Still wanting to show BB-8 around, he took the droid and Valli to a local festival.

For Valentine's Day, Ultros mailed Finn an... unsolicited tentacle pic. Finn lit it on fire with his gun's flamethrower attachment.

With BB-8 wanting to get in on the fight, Finn picked up **PUPPET MASTER.**

The heroes go to the castle in the Empire to await the arrival of Bahamut, knowing they are likely helpless to stop the Eidolon from destroying them all. Upon arrival, they meet with the Empress who reveals herself to have been the Master Summoner all along. She is Ramaa, the reincarnation of Kalki, the Goddess of Darkness defeated in Crystallis. Finn shoots her but she deflects his shot and he kills Ganeshan instead.

She summons Bahamut.



The airship and castle are destroyed by the gigantic Eidolon who's larger than any mountain. During the chaos of trying to get away, the heroes end up on its back. Finn changes to his **CALAMITY KNIGHT** Job for the first time in front of everyone and reveals himself to be the most powerful of the heroes. His strength is still ineffective against Bahamut, so the heroes use their Melodies gained in their first trip to the Empire, a power that's unique to each of them. (Limit Break abilities, basically.)

Because of Bahamut's presence and the use of all the Melodies at once, the heroes destroy space and time.

The young, mysterious girl who appeared randomly to every new arrival now appears again and rewinds time. The heroes keep their memories of the events and are set on a task to make things right in the three days they have before the summoning. Upon their failure, they're sent back again and again and again.

After finally getting everything right (including going on a useless date with Ultros, stealing an airship with Okuyasu and Kenichi, and solving a mystery surrounding a ghost ship), Finn & the heroes manage to meet a woman who helps four of them gain the use of the Legendary Eidolons. Finn is chosen as one of the four. He receives **Zodiark**, the Eidolon of Darkness, though this Eidolon has to be summoned with the use of a special crystal he receives as a gift.

There are five Legendary Eidolons, including Bahamut. They're told that one can only be defeated by the other four.

The heroes then meet Ramaa and Bahamut on an open field, immobilizing him with the Legendary Eidolons. Again using **CALAMITY KNIGHT**, Finn and the rest of the heroes manage to subdue the Empress. While arguing whether they should imprison or kill her (in which Finn argues to kill her himself), she vanishes and escapes.

With the battle won, Vaikuntha goes back to normal.

May 2019

Finn becomes paranoid about the normalcy of the situation. Vaikuntha is saved yet the heroes are still there. With everyone knowing that he's kept **CALAMITY KNIGHT**, Finn begins training with it using the lightsaber. He despises the Job, but Maul persuades him to keep using it during their training.

The other heroes start to ask Finn to get rid of the Job or stop using it, realizing why he's been changing so badly mentally and emotionally in the last few months. He refuses and begins to become paranoid about the other heroes, doubting that they're really his friends and may become his enemies.

Event: On the Island of Christmas, Finn and Ren entered into a temple to pay their respects. There, they unlocked the Eidolon Odin, but Finn did not add him to his roster.

June 2019

Some natives decided to make some money off the presence of the heroes and created a gatcha gaming app for comm devices. All of the heroes featured were invited to a beach retreat where they got to test the game for the first time and get a few free pulls. Finn got cards that featured

Rose, Rey, and Poe. After a very long time where he just kept to himself during the vacation, he had the images printed out and framed for his mantle back home.

Event: Crystals fell out of the sky and the heroes started to race for them. A lot of them fell on Finn's property, which got BB-8 and Valli very interested in the race. After the two ran away without notice, Finn put out a call to the other heroes and stayed home in case they came back.

Event: The Golsaucia Gauntlet returned to Vaikuntha, this time in the form of an arena. Heroes were allowed to participate in pairs, so Finn joined with Maul who had recently started considering Finn his apprentice. Honored by the title, Finn fought with Maul during the Gauntlet.

July 2019

The heroes got word that the Empress fled through the Dream Width to Crystallis. To prepare for the trip, Finn picks up **Shiva**, the Eidolon of Ice, and **SNIPER**, an advanced job.

The heroes make their way to Crystallis and begin searching for the Empress. Finn and a few others request an audience with the Regent of Aques Ixen, this world's capital city, but Finn loses his temper and threatens him, so they get no help. He tries to inquire in a few other places but quickly realizes that he's doing more harm than good and leaves the politics to the others. Other than bailing Bowzer out of jail, he keeps to himself during this time.

However, he does team up with some of the heroes to explore a place that claims to house Eidolons. There, Finn encounters the Knights of the Round but they ignore him once he brings out **CALAMITY KNIGHT**. Turning his attention to support rather than offense, he still helps the other heroes to unlock the Knights. He doesn't try to add them to his team.

August 2019

Finn goes with a large party to a locked away place called the Soul Divider on Crystallis where they believe Ramaa is hiding. They take an elevator down into the depths of the planet, over an hour of a trip, before they arrive in an open cavern to find Ramaa on the edge of the platform. She reveals that she is actually not the reincarnation of Kalki, a revelation that she only just discovered. Ramaa was clearly distraught by the news.

Finn is the first to attack despite her demeanor. Though she seems to die, Ramaa transforms into a giant creature that plays the Soul Divider's harp, what the heroes originally thought was decoration. Through a tough battle, the heroes win. She returns to her normal form and the heroes instantly start arguing about whether or not they should spare her again, even as the rest of the heroes arrive from a separate location. Again, Finn wants to kill her and steps forward to do so before anyone could stop him.

During the bickering, in which Finn can't kill Ramaa due to the younger Frisk standing between them, Balahaka shows up. Along with Meghamaal, Balahaka was also the Empress' right hand. He now reveals himself to be an "Avatar of Calamity" and makes references to everyone's home worlds, even going as far as to refer to Finn as "Darth Finn." He also reveals that the Soul Divider has been absorbing their home worlds this entire time, destroying them to create energy and bring about a new Calamity. Ramaa and Bahamut was a distraction while Balahaka did his work.

Balahaka then takes control of Finn's body, able to do so because of Finn's constant use of **CALAMITY KNIGHT**. The other two Knights, Maul and Sephiroth, follow him willingly.

They're then dispatched to other worlds to make sure the Soul Dividers are able to destroy everything without being disturbed.

In his home universe, the Soul Divider has been relocated to Dathomir, the home planet of Maul who has taken over the First Order and declared himself Emperor. Finn, now referred to as Darth Martis, is now under Maul's control. With orders, he's often left to his devices so long as he carries them out.

Finn finds out that the Star Destroyer he's been given control of has a prisoner and quickly figures out that it's Poe Dameron, one of his closest friends. He helps Poe to escape, refusing to go with him, and sends along instructions to the other heroes of how they can destroy the Soul Divider.

Poe and the heroes take control of a new Starkiller Base. From Starkiller, they're able to destroy the Soul Divider without destroying Dathomir. Finn and Maul arrived to Starkiller just as the Soul Divider was destroyed. A battle begins.

Maul is killed in combat, but Finn can't bring himself to kill Poe or his friends who have come there to save him. He manages to break free of the control and finally loses **CALAMITY KNIGHT**. Despite forsaking what had happened to him, Finn takes the Darksaber from Maul's body.

Promising Poe that he'd return, Finn goes back to Vaikuntha with the others where they face Balahaka and the Cloud of Darkness after saving most of the other worlds. Sephiroth and their enemies all fall in battle and the multiverse is saved.

Though he tries to undo the damage that the Soul Divider did to the galaxy, Finn's unable to fix everything the timeline disrupted. He does, however, keep his promise and goes back home to Poe.

MASTER (1000 exp)

Outfit: Black t-shirt under a black jacket with red accents along the trim. Black tactical pants and black combat boots. Red Corellian Bloodstripes on his pants is an homage to Han Solo.

Equipment: Two large handguns holstered to his thighs, two pistols holstered to his ribs beneath the jacket, and a small pistol on his back beneath the jacket. The two large

	handguns double as flamethrowers. Due to the ability Bandana , he has infinite ammo.
 Chemist	<p>MASTER (2235 exp)</p> <p>Outfit: Shirt, pants, and boots are the same clothes given to him by Poe at the start of TLJ despite that Finn loses the latter two during the film. Long, olive, canvas coat covers him almost completely and has many pockets. A canvas knapsack is also slung over his back with various jars and bobbles pinned to the strap.</p> <p>Equipment: The fire-attuned dagger gifted to him from the soldiers at Fort Armstrong and ornate hand cannon gifted to him from Red during Starlight. Also, a large variety of potions and ingredients to make anything he could need. Experimental Phoenix Downs are also on his person.</p>
 Summoner	<p>MASTER (1000 exp)</p> <p>Outfit: Tight, black, sleeveless tank and black pants with slender black boots ornamented with silver buckles. A sheer, sleeveless, white robe covers his person and ends in five points decorated with silver bells around his ankles. Left arm has one silver bracelet, right arm has several. Left ear has three stud earrings, right ear has one stud at the top and three hoops at the bottom that gets progressively bigger towards his neck, all silver. One silver eyebrow piercing on the right side. Tweed necklace holds a white pouch containing Zodiark's crystal.</p> <p>Equipment: Skywalker's lightsaber before it was broken. Zodiark's crystal kept in a pouch against his chest, but he was only able to use it once.</p>
 Archaeologist	<p>(200 exp)</p> <p>Outfit: Poe's shirt with khakis and leather boots. The mended jacket from TLJ with a rope wound across his chest from shoulder to rib. Brown high-crowned, wide-brimmed fedora.</p> <p>Equipment: One revolver at his right hip and a whip at his left.</p>
 Puppet Master	<p>(750 exp)</p> <p>Outfit: Gray knit sweater, dark pants, boots, and a brown leather jacket with polished brass clasps.</p> <p>Equipment: No weapons. BB-8 appears as the puppet. Rarely used in combat.</p>
 Calamity Knight	<p>(400 exp)</p> <p>Outfit: Black t-shirt, black pants, black combat boots, black leather gloves. Black leather trench coat clasped down to the hips. Black helmet completely obscuring the face with a dark faceplate and silver lining near the eyes mimicking a stormtrooper mask. Note: While using this job, Finn's irises are a dark, glowing purple and there are purple lines</p>

like infected veins reaching down from his eyes.

Equipment: Skywalker's lightsaber and Maul's darksaber.



Sniper

ADVANCED (Gunslinger + Summoner)

Outfit: Light gray $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve fitted shirt under dark gray short sleeve tactical jacket. Dark gray tactical pants, black combat boots, dark gray tactical gloves. UV black sunglasses with information display built into the lenses available if needed.

Equipment: 50 cal. sniper rifle with built-in attachments if needed.

Finn's Eidolons



Ramuh (Thunder)

"A primordial Eidolon believed to have once been corrupted by the goddess of death spoken of in the ancient legends. Ramuh is the patron deity of scholars, being one of the few Eidolons known not only for his might but also for his infinite wisdom. Summoners wishing to have him on their side should travel to the Great McGard Library and pray in his shrine until the wise man answers their call." Finn's first Eidolon.

Titan (Earth)

"A primordial Eidolon believed to have been defeated and saved by the heroes spoken of in the ancient legends. Titan is a giant, taller and larger than any other Eidolon. Legends said he once held on his back a meteor that threatened to destroy the world. Those wishing to harness the giant's power should find a cave in Cactuar Island and pray for the giant to heed their call."





Shiva (Ice)

“A primordial Eidolon believed to have existed in the chaos before Vaikuntha was created. The Goddess of Ice is worshipped as the protector of Lavode by those who still believe in ancient legends. Summoners who wish to harness her power should go to the Temple of Lavode in pilgrimage and pray until the goddess answers their call.”

Zodiark (Darkness)

“One of the five Legendary Eidolons spoken of in Vaikunthan Legends. It is one of the four that answered the calls of the Heroes of Light to defeat the Lord of Eidolons, Bahamut. As a Legendary Eidolon, it can only be used by one who has the 3000 EXP skill, even for partial and egi summoning. Furthermore, a Summoner can attune only to one of the five Legendary Eidolons and their choice is permanent. This Eidolon doesn't count as part of the maximum of Eidolons a summoner can hold.” The only Legendary Finn has and will ever hold, given to him by the Eidolon's creator from Crystallis.
