Our quarter peal weekend for 2025 will be held in the Alton and Petersfield area of Hampshire.

We will start the weekend with general ringing at East Meon 10 (18-0-12) on Friday afternoon, from 2pm until 3.15pm. This was the only time the bells were available to us to ring as a group so please do support this if you can.

Following the general ringing the weekend will follow a similar format to previous years with quarter peal attempts arranged at several local towers during Friday late afternoon and evening and Saturday during the day, before a meal at the Alton House Hotel on Saturday evening.
