Tardies / Absences

As a school, we have had **922** tardies (versus 1,550 last term)

- This is down more than 50% since we started tracking (2,200 in fall of 2022).
- We have **310** students who have zero tardies for the year (50% of our students)
- Tardies by grade level:

7th: 203

8th: 455 (660 last term)

9th: 264 (640 last term)

Our attendance total for the term was **92%** (91% last term)

We have **54** students who have **100%** attendance and **ZERO** tardies for the year!

Behaviors

We have had a total of 48 disruptive behaviors thus far this term.

- This is AWESOME, and it is well below the pace set last year!

Term 1: **152** incidents
Term 2: **228** incidents
Term 3: **140** incidents
Term 4: **103** incidents

The areas that have seen decreases include:

Harassment (**5** v 23)
Disruptive behaviors (**4** v 16)
Truancy (**7** v 11)
Vaping (**8** v 13)
Fighting (**0** v 5)

Grades

We have a total of **140** students (23%) with at least one F right now.

- This is a high number of failing students, but things usually come down dramatically the last couple weeks of the term.
- By grade level:

7th: 40
8th: 61
9th: 39

GPA

We currently have 316 students (52%) with a 3.5+ GPA
