### **IHSA Information**

The most significant update from this past week involved high-risk sports in Regions that have improved from Tier 1 to Phase 4. Schools within a Phase 4 Region can now conduct intra-conference and intra-region contests in high-risk sports. Moderate-risk sports competing outdoors in Phase 4 also received expanded scheduling opportunities, including tournaments and out-of-state contests.

#### Other notes from IHSA:

- All winter low risk sports must conduct practice seven days prior to their first contest. Basketball teams must conduct 12 days of practice prior to their first contest. Fall, spring, and summer sports can begin contact days on Monday based on the allowances of your EMS Region and local school district approval.
- ☐ Masks must be worn in practice and competition. Social distancing should be adhered to for bench players and game personnel. Schools must follow the mitigations and guidelines established by the IHSA.

The IHSA Board of Directors is scheduled to meet again this Wednesday. They will be working to establish season schedules.

As administrators, please be patient with us as we quickly make the transition from advocacy to action. We will share news and updates for each sport as soon as possible.
