

The *New* Linwood Park Company Joint Standing Beach & Bluff Committee

To assure that we are doing all we can to preserve and maintain our beach for current and future generations, the Linwood Park Company Board of Directors created the *New* Beach & Bluff Committee on June 29, 2021. It is a Joint Standing Committee, initially comprised of 4 Linwood Park Company shareholders who are *not* currently members of the Board, and 2 Linwood Park Company Directors.

Purposes Of New Beach & Bluff Committee:

- To create transparency and community involvement in the process of managing our beach and bluffs
- To continually monitor the Linwood Park beach and bluffs, and to evaluate and recommend measures to mitigate erosion of the beach and the bluff.
- To learn and remain current on the evolving “state-of-the-art” beach erosion protection measures.
- To evaluate and recommend actions for improving beach resiliency and beach enjoyment for Linwood Park stakeholders and guests.

Scope Of Committee:

- Continually monitor the changing condition of the beach and bluff
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness, condition and impact of current erosion control structures.
- Study and evaluate potential new or unused measures for erosion control.

- Monitor, evaluate and recommend beach grooming and maintenance procedures, and beach access and use policies.
- Monitor Lake Erie water quality at Linwood Park Beach

Authority Of Committee:

- This Committee is authorized and charged with the responsibility *ONLY* to present committee findings and recommendations to The Linwood Park Company Board of Directors. All decisions for action and implementation will be made solely by the Board of Directors.
