

Privacy Policy

NutrioMN (“Nutrio,” “we,” “our,” or “us”) respects your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how Nutrio collects, uses, stores, and protects information when you use the NutrioMN mobile app.

NutrioMN is designed for general wellness, food logging, calorie tracking, and nutrition awareness. NutrioMN does not provide medical advice, diagnosis, treatment, or disease prevention.

1. Information We Collect

Account Information

NutrioMN may require or allow users to create an account in order to use account-based features such as saving food logs, syncing data, and accessing app functionality across sessions.

When you create an account, we may collect:

- Email address
- User account ID
- Authentication-related information
- Basic profile or preference information you choose to provide

Nutrition and Food Log Data

When you use NutrioMN, you may enter or generate nutrition-related information, including:

- Foods logged
- Calories
- Macronutrients
- Meal history
- Saved foods
- Recipes or food items viewed or saved
- Weight, goals, activity level, or similar profile inputs if you choose to provide them
- Water intake or other tracking information if available in the app

This information is used to provide calorie tracking, food diary, nutrition insights, and related app functionality.

Meal Photos and Camera-Based Features

If you use meal photo scan or camera-based food logging, the image you capture or select may be sent to our backend or configured analysis service to estimate food and nutrition information.

Meal photos are used only to provide app functionality. We do not sell meal photos or use them for cross-app advertising tracking.

Search Queries

When you search for foods, recipes, or nutrition information, your search terms may be processed by NutriMN, our backend services, or third-party services in order to return relevant results.

Device and App Information

NutriMN may process limited technical information necessary to operate, secure, debug, and improve the app, such as app version, device type, crash-related information, and general diagnostic information.

2. How Your Data Is Stored

NutriMN may store data in the following ways:

Local Device Storage

Some app data and preferences may be stored locally on your device, including through tools such as AsyncStorage, SQLite, or similar local storage technologies.

Cloud Storage and Backend Services

If account-based features are enabled, your account information, food logs, nutrition entries, saved foods, preferences, and related app data may be stored using backend services such as Supabase.

Cloud-backed data is associated with your account so that the app can provide login, sync, backup, and account-based functionality.

3. How We Use Information

We use information to:

- Create and manage user accounts
- Authenticate users
- Save and sync food logs
- Provide calorie, macro, and nutrition tracking
- Display nutrition insights and progress summaries
- Provide food search and recipe search results
- Analyze meal photos when users choose to use scan features
- Store preferences such as language, theme, and onboarding state
- Improve reliability, fix bugs, and maintain app functionality
- Respond to support, privacy, or account deletion requests

4. Third-Party Services

NutrioMN may use third-party services to provide certain features. These may include:

Supabase

Purpose: Authentication, user accounts, database storage, backend functionality, and cloud sync.

Data processed: Account information, user ID, food logs, nutrition entries, preferences, and related app data.

Spoonacular

Purpose: Recipe search, recipe details, and nutrition information.

Data processed: Search queries, recipe IDs, and related recipe requests when you use recipe features.

USDA FoodData Central or USDA-Based Food Data

Purpose: Food search and nutrition data.

Data processed: Food search queries and related food/nutrition requests.

Meal Scan or AI Analysis Services

Purpose: Estimating food and nutrition information from meal photos when the scan feature is used.

Data processed: Images selected or captured by the user and related analysis results.

These third-party services process information only as needed to provide app functionality. Their handling of information may also be governed by their own terms and privacy practices.

5. Data Sharing

We do not sell, rent, or share your personal information with third parties for advertising or marketing purposes.

We may share or process limited information with service providers only as necessary to:

- Provide app functionality
- Store and sync account data
- Return food, recipe, or nutrition results
- Analyze meal photos if the user chooses to use scan features
- Maintain app security and reliability
- Comply with legal obligations if required

6. Tracking and Advertising

NutrioMN does not use your data for cross-app tracking.

NutrioMN does not sell your personal information.

NutrioMN does not use meal logs, nutrition data, or meal photos for third-party advertising.

7. Data Security

We use reasonable technical and organizational measures to protect user information.

For cloud-backed data, we use backend services such as Supabase and access controls designed to restrict user data to the appropriate account.

For local data stored on your device, we recommend using device security features such as a passcode, Face ID, Touch ID, or other device protections.

No method of electronic storage or transmission is completely secure, so we cannot guarantee absolute security.

8. Data Retention and Deletion

Local Data

Data stored locally on your device may remain on the device until you delete it through the app, clear app data, or uninstall the app.

Account and Cloud Data

If you create an account, account-related data may remain stored in our backend systems unless deleted through an in-app account deletion feature or by contacting us.

You may request deletion of your account and associated data by contacting us at:

If an in-app account deletion feature is available, you may also use that feature to request or complete deletion of your account.

Some limited information may be retained if necessary for security, legal compliance, fraud prevention, or legitimate operational purposes.

9. Children's Privacy

NutrioMN is not intended for children under the age of 13.

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you believe that a child has provided personal information through NutrioMN, please contact us so we can review and delete the information if appropriate.

10. Medical Disclaimer

NutrioMN is intended for general wellness, calorie tracking, food logging, and nutrition awareness only.

NutrioMN does not provide medical advice, diagnosis, treatment, disease prevention, or medical monitoring.

Nutrition estimates, calorie estimates, macro estimates, recipe data, and meal scan outputs may be inaccurate or incomplete. Users should not rely on NutrioMN as a substitute for professional medical, nutritional, or dietary advice.

If you have a medical condition, dietary restriction, eating disorder history, allergy, or specific health concern, consult a qualified healthcare professional.
