



Paying Your Pledge

Pledges need not be paid all at once. In fact, we prefer that you make regular monthly installments. However, what works best for you is what works best for us. We only ask that you honor your pledge and that payments are completed by the end of the fiscal year. The First Unitarian fiscal year is July 1 – June 30.

By Check

Checks made out to First Unitarian may be mailed to the office (48 Monroe Place, Brooklyn, NY 11201) or dropped in the offering plate on Sunday. Please mark your check pledge (fiscal year) in the memo line.

On-Line

Go to www.fuub.org. Click on the Donate Here button, choose Pledge Payments and follow the directions. On-line donations can be set up to make regular payments. Please help to defray credit card charges by adding 1.75% to your payments. Payments made by debit card or account transfer do not incur charges.

Your Bank's Bill Pay System

Set up First Unitarian as you would any other bill. Checks should be sent to 48 Monroe Place, Brooklyn, NY 11201. Please mark your check pledge (fiscal year) in the memo line.

Cash

We do not recommend that you pay your pledge with cash. However, if you do, enclose cash in a sealed envelope marked with your name(s), the amount enclosed and the note "Pledge (fiscal year)". Note: Cash put in the offering plate on Sunday that is not marked as a pledge and including your name, cannot be credited to your account.
