* Samuel was sent to New South Wales, Australia as a convict in 1826. His trial was on 4 March 1826. On records in Australia he is listed as "alias Gay". He was sentenced to death at trial, but was changed to life. In 1842 he was granted a pardon.

Note: Ann Collett's first husband was Aaron Gay 25 Oct 1790 in Broughton Gifford; they had one daughter, Ann, who was born 1790 and died 1794. I can't find a death for Aaron.
