Option 1: If you already have a UMD MyU account setup and working:

 - ◆ Log in with your University of Minnesota Internet ID, password, and DUO (2-factor authentication).
 - ◆ Your available course evaluations will be listed.
 - ◆ Select the course, complete the evaluation, and save.

Option 2: If you need to setup your UMD MyU account and evaluate this dual enrollment course:

<u>Step 1</u>: Obtain your University of Minnesota Student ID number from the letter that was mailed to you from the UMD CITS program office, OR request your ID from your high school CITS teacher.

<u>Step 2</u>: Initiate and Manage Your University of Minnesota Student Account.

The first step to getting online at UMD is to obtain your University of Minnesota Internet ID and password by initiating your account.

- ◆ Enter your University of Minnesota student ID. Example: 1234567
- ◆ Do not enter the Last 4 digits of your Social Security Number. Leave this field blank.
- ◆ Enter your Birthdate as YYYY-MM-DD (ex: 2020-03-31). This is required.
- ◆ Create a password and write it down. Please view the tips on how to create a good password. Keep your password handy, but safe. (*Do not share your password with anyone else*.)
- ◆ Click Submit
- → Write down your University of Minnesota Internet ID. Example: champ021

Enroll in and Use Duo Security

The University uses Duo Security (two-factor authentication) to secure all current students, faculty, and staff internet accounts.
