
Brave New World Reading Calendar April 2018

Also, at the conclusion of each book club, your group will provide me with a discussion log with meeting notes and reflections on what new insights you learned from each other, powerful passages (sections of text) that caught your attention, any connections/ events that you were reminded of in this reading, any questions that you were thinking about at the end of this reading, and how the meeting could go better for the next round. You can use the Dystopian Handout in your discussion logs to record: characteristics of a dystopian society, types of dystopian control, and evidence of the dystopian protagonist(s). Each person must upload his/her study guide and discussion log to Google Classroom.
