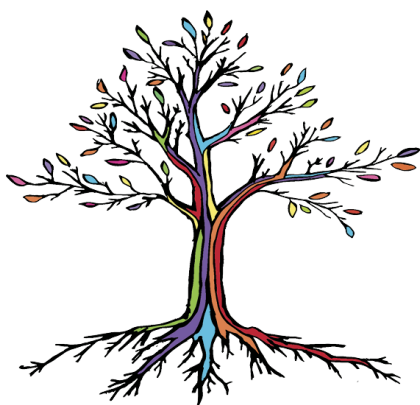




Rainbow Tree Therapies

child's natural play space providing just right challenges for motor development while providing rich sensory input. Rainbow Tree adheres closely to supporting the mind, body, and spirit of children. We define spirit as the connection with others and the natural world. Hours will range from 3-10 hours per week with potential for more hours. All candidates must possess a Master's degree from an accredited program and be licensed in the State of Wisconsin. No benefits are provided but wage is competitive. This is a cash based business model so no dealings with insurance companies but documentation, evaluation, goal writing and development of home programs as appropriate will be required. We are located 10-15 minutes from Stillwater, Minnesota and Hudson WI, & Somerset WI off of County Rd E in St. Joseph Township (Hudson, WI). Additional requirements include:

1. One year experience in pediatrics including pediatric assessments but new grads welcome to apply.
2. Knowledge of the following: typical motor development of children, sensory processing, mind/body connection, self regulation & emotional management using tools such as zones of regulation, deep breathing, yoga, mindfulness and meditation.
3. Experience in working with children who may have a diagnosis of ASD, ADHD, ADD, Anxiety.
4. Love of nature and can envision what therapy looks like outdoors in all seasons. Experience or comfort with animals is preferred but not required.
5. Pass a background check.
6. Proof of professional liability insurance.
7. Ability to communicate clearly with others and in particular caregivers.
8. Independent self starter with an intentional mindset of service delivery to achieve functional outcomes in natural settings.
9. Keen observation skills to adapt activities to that just-right challenge for advancement of functional outcomes.
10. Flexible with work hours knowing that some hours will likely be in the after school time slot of 3:30-6:00 p.m. or possible weekends.
11. CPR certified is preferred.
12. Physically capable to engage with clients in nature.
