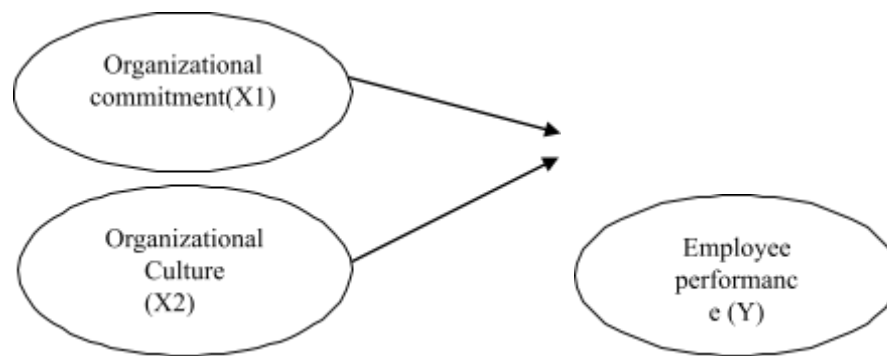


Figure 1 . Title Pictures, letters *Times New Roman* 10 pt, spaced 1
