Band typically plays 7pm-10pm with an early sound check at 1pm.

Brass Mash Recommendations for Your Event.

1. For 150 minutes of entertainment please allow two 15 minute breaks.
2. Stage Space of 18ft x 12ft (For a 10 member arrangement)
3. Stage is further than 12ft of seated guests (as in eating a meal during a performance)
4. Power meets or exceeds residential 30amp circuit or 3000watt generator (to be provided by venue)
5. Adequate doors and nearby parking access in order to easily "wheel in" heavy equipment
6. 3 hours of facilities access (cumulative) is provided before performance to accommodate equipment load in, setup time and sound check.
7. Stage surface is of a solid material (Preferably not grass, gravel, sand or similar).
8. Noise ordinances and rules communicated (permits, county quiet hours, decibel levels)
9. Communication on all relevant times for your event (load in, ceremony, start time, stop times, break, and any specific preference)
10. Band parking for 6-10 vehicles.
11. Preferences on the location of band members during any and all time periods during your event (Setup, guest arrival time, ceremonies, receptions, etc)
12. Information regarding band members with food, beverages, restrooms, preparation rooms, car access and cell phone access.
