#### **Principal Sheridan Report:**

- Teacher Check-ins
  - o Pre-K not present
  - o Kinder Spring and plants unit for science; starting the chicks hatching exercise hatching in 2 weeks; Crows Nest field trip on 4/18;
  - o First Just did Texas program/play and Texas unit. Starting deserts and rainforest; money and time in Math; working on readers theatres plays.
  - o Second Not present
  - o Third Map skills; test taking strategies ahead of STAAR; spiral review; math starting capacity, just wrapped up 2D and 3D shapes; Kristen Curry KXAN meteorologist is coming next week to speak; canned food drive coming in May for Capital Area Food Bank.
  - Fourth Science water cycle; Math finishing data analysis; 2 field trips coming up – LCRA and new Texas Natural History Museum; LA – focused on test taking skills.
  - o Fifth Shout out to kids that participated in Hello World competition (16 kids); Reading – wrapping up literature circles; summaries and context clues; Social Studies – Constitution, 3 branches of Government and Bill of Rights; Math – classifying 2D skills and moving on to test prep
  - o SPED Just had another Best Buddies event today, typically do one a month. Friendship walk at Westlake Stadium on 4/20.
  - Special Areas No updates for Art or Music; PE just finished volleyball, doing outdoor/backyard games for next 2 weeks; striking – racquets/bats, etc. coming up. Kids Heart Challenge – raised \$28,000
  - o DLI Naming ceremony for Kindergarten next week

- <u>STAAR Interim Update</u> Took interim tests in February and have been doing tutoring as needed.
  - o Math interim target was 69%, actual was 79%. High Focus Math target 66%, actual rate 59%, Lowest race 1 (AA) target 61%, actual rate 50%; Lowest race 2 (Hispanic) Target 68%, actual rate 42%. Academic Achievement Meets leveltarget 49%, actual 78%
  - o RLA 64% target, 83% actual rate. High focus missed by 1 student, met in AA, short in Hispanic by 2 students. All groups met in Meets level
- STAAR Dates Reading 4/16; Science (fifth) 4/18; Math 4/25
- Pride Week Recap Week was great; end of week slideshow was a hit. Focus lessons on SEL, vocabulary, etc.
- Staffing Update for 2024-2025 Fully staffed in classroom teachers. Going to interview for Art next week, interviewing for Music as well.
- Class Making input closes today; staff will start meeting in April to start making classes.
- <u>CIP Update Ahead of meets levels on all goals.</u> Grade level reading, Respect and Well-being, etc.
- Math Olympiad Tournament hosted at Doss this year for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders.
  Tournament is on 4/20 for Central Texas.
- Future Problem Solvers State Tournament in Waco; all 5<sup>th</sup> grade teams made the state bowl; need a parent to take the reins for next school year.
