

TO TUTORS CONDUCTING CAN-DO CHALLENGE:

Additional information about CAN-DO Challenge Lv.1 and Lv.2 tasks:

In the Tutor's Guide, we included a note below some specific tasks, requesting tutors to consider the student's answer if they use a different phrase during the role-play, provided that the intended meaning remains the same as indicated in the task. *(See example below)*

Task2:

Tell the person that you will see if James is available and then ask if you can put him/her on hold.

*Accept the student's answer if he/she uses a different phrase but with a similar meaning.

Target Expressions:

I'll see if . . .

Can I put you on hold?

In this example, the student might say, "I'll **check** if James is available" instead of "I'll **see** if James is available."

While we allow students to use expressions not introduced in the material, we included this note to emphasize that the student might articulate the task differently. In such cases, tutors should provide corrections only if necessary.
