GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In an effort to provide balance and a healthy academic culture, the expectation and standard course load for all students is six academic classes and no more than four Advanced Placement (AP) courses in a school year. Any exception must file a petition with the Assistant Head of Upper School for Academics.

Courses in parenthesis are the names used prior to the 2024-2025 school year.

These minimum departmental requirements for graduation must be earned in grades 9-12:

ENGLISH <i>4 Years</i>	• Honors English 1 (English 9) • Honors English 2 (English 10) • AP English Language and Composition (English 11) • AP English Literature and Composition (English 12)
SOCIAL & RELIGIOUS STUDIES <i>3.5 Years</i>	• Honors World History: Early Modern (History 9) • AP World History: Modern (History 10) • Honors United States History: Finding Frontiers in America OR AP United States History (History 11) • 1 semester Religious Studies course during the sophomore, junior, or senior year
MATHEMATICS <i>3 Years taken in grades 9-12</i>	• Must include courses at or above the level of: • Honors Algebra 1 • Honors Geometry • Honors Algebra 2 (Integrated Algebra 2) OR Advanced Algebra 2
SCIENCE <i>3 Years</i>	• Honors Biology • Honors Physics OR Advanced Physics • Honors Chemistry OR Advanced Chemistry (Quantitative Chemistry)
MODERN & CLASSICAL LANGUAGES <i>2-3 Years</i>	Successful completion of at least Level 3 in Latin, Spanish or Mandarin with at least two of these years/levels completed in high school
FINE ARTS <i>2 Years</i>	Generally one earned in grade 9 and one earned in grade 10
ATHLETICS	Successful completion of four seasons in 9th and 10th grades, one of which must be a team sport
COMMUNITY SERVICE	Successful completion of 40 hours of approved, voluntary community service occurring between the end of 8 th grade and May 1st of senior year. Hours must be submitted using the school's online system.
HEALTH / WELLNESS DEVELOPMENT	Successful completion of programs in grades 9, 10, 11, 12
SENIOR PROJECT	Successful completion of the Senior Project
FLEX	Successful completion of one semester of stewardship
